Subject: **Government Order (GO) for Participation in the 9th Asia-Pacific Climate Change Adaptation Forum and Ministerial Roundtable, Bangkok, Thailand (29 September–03 October 2025)**

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh for Her Excellency **Ms. Syeda Rizwana Hasan** (Passport No. **D00017713**), **Honorable Adviser** to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change as well as the Ministry of Water Resources, to participate in the *9th Asia-Pacific Climate Change Adaptation Forum* and the *Ministerial Roundtable* as a panel member, scheduled to be held at the United Nations Conference Centre (UNCC), **Bangkok, Thailand**, from **29 September to 03 October 2025**. The program is being organized by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and the Asia Pacific Adaptation Network (APAN), in collaboration with UNESCAP, ADB, and APN. This approval is accorded under the following terms and conditions:


2. Terms and conditions
 - i. The Honorable Adviser will commence her journey to Thailand on or around 28 September 2025 and return on or around 04 October 2025, depending on travel convenience;
 - ii. The entire duration of the visit, including travel and transit, shall be treated as on duty;
 - iii. She will draw her pay and allowances in local currency, and no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
 - iv. The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) will bear relevant expenses, including international travel, daily subsistence allowance, and terminal expenses, during her participation in the Forum. However, Any additional expenditure, if required for protocol obligations or to fulfill entitlements as per government rules, may be met from the Cabinet Division's budget under the head "Travel Expenses-03-1040301-100121-3244101"; and
 - v. She will not stay abroad beyond the approved period, except for necessary travel time.
3. This order is issued with the approval of the competent authority.
