

2. Terms and conditions

- i. The official will commence his journey to the USA on or around 03 October 2025 and return on or around 26 October 2025, depending on travel convenience;
- ii. The entire duration of the visit, including travel and transit, shall be treated as on duty;
- iii. He will draw his pay and allowances in local currency, and no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
- iv. All expenses related to his participation in the program will be borne by the U.S. Government (Department of State/IVLP). **There will be no financial involvement from the Government of Bangladesh;**
- v. He will not stay abroad beyond the approved period (except for travel time);
- vi. He must report back to his office immediately upon completion of the program; and
- vii. He is required to submit a report on the event(s) to the Admin-2 Section of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change within seven days of his return.
