2. Terms and conditions

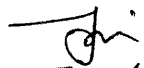
- The officials will commence their journey to **Bhutan** on a convenient date near **23 April 2025**;
- The duration of the program, including travel and **transit through Nepal**, shall be considered on duty;
- The officials will draw their pay and allowances in local currency; no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
- ADB, BIMSTEC Secretariat, and the Royal Government of Bhutan will bear all expenses related to participation in the training. **There will be no financial involvement from the Government of Bangladesh;**
- The officials shall not stay abroad beyond the approved duration, except for necessary travel time;
- They must return to their workplace immediately after completing the training;
- They are required to submit a report on the training program to the Admin-2 Section of the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change within seven days of their return.
- This order supersedes and cancels the previous Government Order (Memo No. 22.00.0000.052.25.007.24.159, dated 10 April 2025) that approved the participation of Mr. Mohammad Razib Siddique.
