

2. Terms and conditions
  - i. The official will commence the journey to Thailand on or around 13 October 2025 and return on or around 17 October 2025, depending on travel convenience;

  - iii. He will draw his pay and allowances in local currency, and no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
  - iv. All expenses related to his participation in the event will be borne by the organizer(s) (UNODC). **There will be no financial involvement from the Government of Bangladesh;**
  - v. He will not stay abroad beyond the approved period (except for travel time);
  - vi. He must report back to his office immediately upon completion of the meeting; and
  - vii. He is required to submit a report on the event(s) to the Administration-2 Section of the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change within seven days of his return.
