  - iii. They will draw their pay and allowances in local currency; no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
  - iv. All expenses related to his participation will be borne by the SAWEN Secretariat. **There will be no financial involvement from the Government of Bangladesh;**
  - v. They will not extend their stay abroad beyond the approved period (except for unavoidable travel exigencies);
  - vi. Upon return, they must report to their respective offices immediately; and
  - vii. Each official must submit a report on the workshop to the Administration-2 Section of this Ministry within seven (07) days of return.
