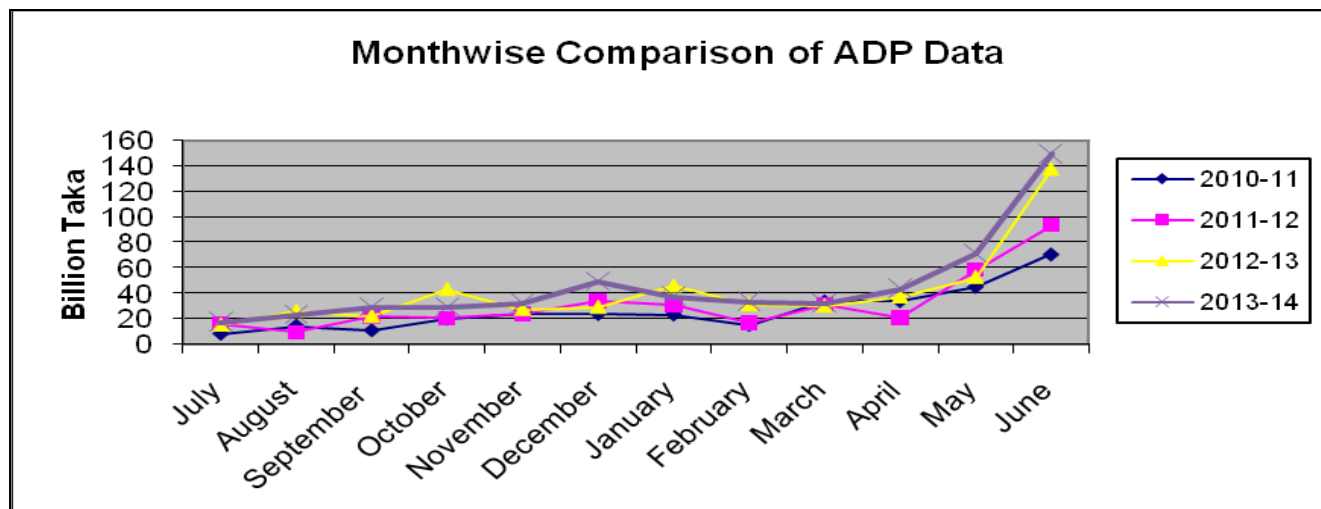

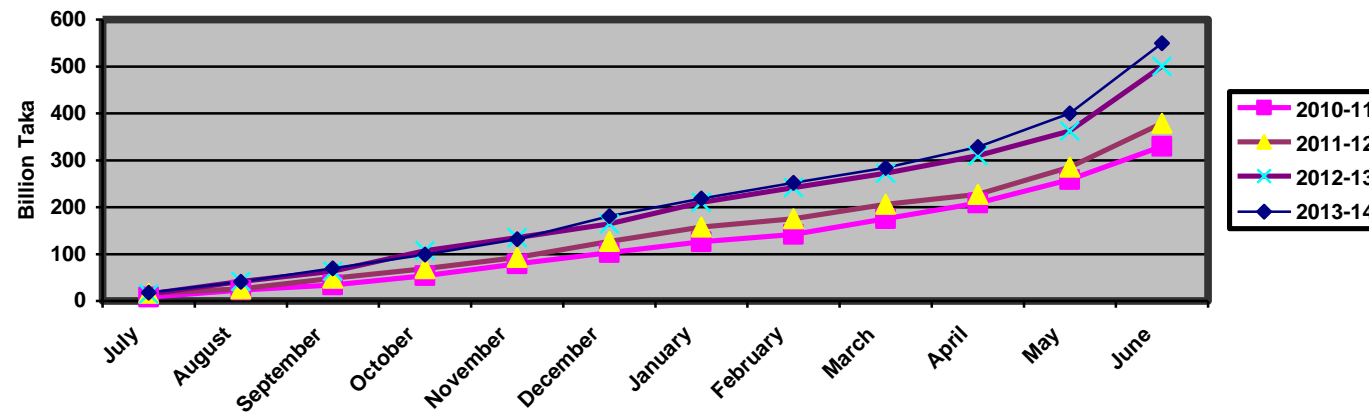

Cumulative ADP Expenditure



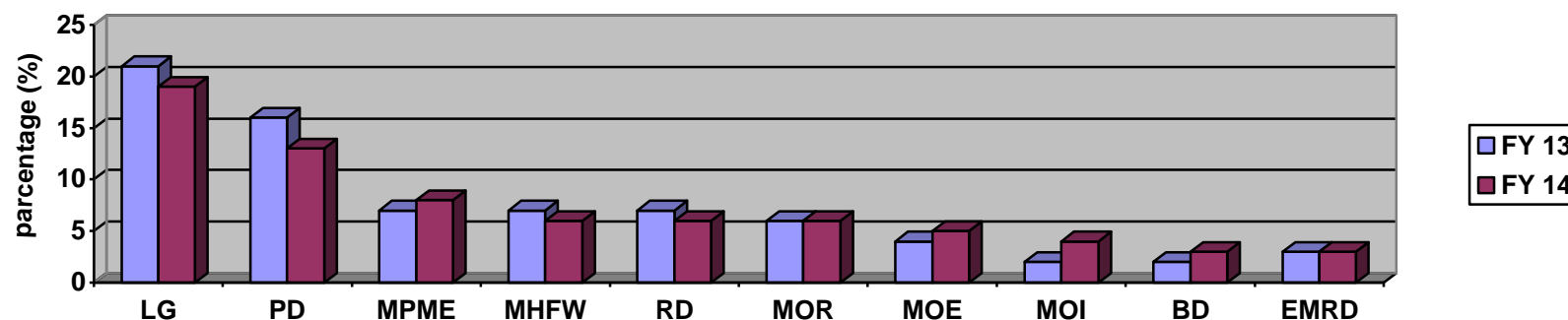
