## *Annex 1*

### **Eligibility criteria for the nominee:**

- A minimum academic average of 70% or higher in undergraduate studies;
- Preferably candidates aged 35 or younger;
- Proficiency in English, with the level to be assessed by the country of the nominee;
- Civil/public servant;

### **Scholarship content:**

- Tuition Fee Waiver: All students will receive a tuition-free education;
- Accommodation: International students will be provided with free accommodation at the University of Prishtina's Student Center;
- Monthly allowance (For eight months, 500 Euro per month);
- Three meals a day;
- Free health services;
- Round-trip flight tickets.

### **Visa application procedures:**

- Citizens of the People's Republic of Bangladesh require visas to enter the Republic of Kosovo;
- Applications for D Visa will be processed from distance;
- The enrolled candidate will be provided with visa procedure information;

### **I. MASTER'S PROGRAM IN HUMAN RIGHTS, INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL LAW AND TRANSITIONAL JUSTICE**

---

#### **Program Overview:**

This one-year Master's program (60 ECTS) is designed to prepare 30 professionals in the fields of Human Rights, International Criminal Law, and Transitional Justice. The curriculum offers a thorough exploration of contemporary and relevant issues at local, regional, and international levels.

Courses will be taught by distinguished international Co-Professors from leading universities across Europe and the United States. These experts will provide both lectures and mentorship.

The program is supported by the Faculty of Law at the University of Prishtina and esteemed partners, including the Government of Switzerland, the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, and the Council of Europe.

## OVERVIEW OF THE MASTER'S PROGRAMS IN ENGLISH

### **I. MASTER'S PROGRAM IN INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT (MP-IWRM)**

---

#### **Program Overview:**

The Master's Program in Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM) is hosted by the Department of Hydro Technics at the Faculty of Civil Engineering, University of Prishtina. This program is offered in collaboration with other faculties within the University of Prishtina "Hasan Prishtina", the University of Peja, and additional partners. The primary goal of the IWRM-K Program is to develop enduring capacities for water resources management at both national and river basin levels, aligning with Kosova's socio-economic and political priorities and supporting sustainable development goals.

Throughout the program, students will have the unique opportunity to explore various facets of water use and management, including hydro technical, biophysical, environmental, legal, institutional, and socio-economic perspectives in an integrated manner. The program aims to enhance students' hydro technical and computational skills, deepen their understanding of environmental impacts, and foster effective management abilities. It is designed to facilitate the transition from fragmented water management practices to a modern, cohesive water governance system.

#### **Program Structure and Duration:**

The Master of Science in Integrated Water Resources Management is achieved by completing four semesters of coursework. The first three semesters, each lasting 15 weeks, include theoretical courses, laboratory work, and fieldwork. In total, students will accumulate 120 ECTS credits: 90 ECTS from coursework and practical exercises during the first three semesters, and 30 ECTS in the fourth semester, comprising 10 ECTS from an internship and 20 ECTS from a research project and Master's thesis. Upon completion, students will be awarded a Master's degree in Civil Engineering with a specialization in Hydro Technics from the IWRM Program.
