Introduction

The Government of Bangladesh has amended the visa policy to address the need for a clear, modern and service oriented immigration framework. This Policy clearly defines 34 visa categories, their validity and extension procedures. The rationality of new visa policy can be assessed by examining its potential impact on the country's Socio-economic landscape.

A well-designed visa policy can foster smooth arrival and departure of the foreigners. New visa policy that simplifies entry for investors, business travelers and skilled workers that can attract Foreign Direct Investment and drive economic expansion. A more welcoming visa policy can boost tourism sector with significant growth in Bangladesh. Simplified visa procedure can attract more tourists leading to revenue generation and job creation in the tourism and hospitality industries. Besides this visa policy will encourage skilled migration that can facilitate the transfer of knowledge and technology.

Visa policy-2026 is based on reciprocity with other countries ensuring a balanced approach to international travel. This will not affect diplomatic relation and international partnerships for our careful consideration and communication. We hope this policy will strike a balance between facilitating travel and ensuring national Security potentially requiring on going adjustment and monitoring.

Effective implementation of this policy requires close collaboration and coordination among all agencies including Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Mandatory visa conditions (Visa Policy 2026)

1. The Ministry of Home Affairs will formulate policy relating to visa and immigration. The Department of Immigration and Passports will be the authority for issuing visa including NVR, Visa on Arrival, transit visa, exit pass, route change permit, and change of visa category in Bangladesh. Bangladesh Missions will be the visa issuing authority in abroad. A visa is to be issued upon considering individual application on case-to-case basis after careful examination of documents and on being fully satisfied about the purpose of the visit and keeping records in writing. Visa issuing authority may refer an issue to the Ministry of Home Affairs for any decision, if necessary. Original Passports of visa applicants are to be submitted to visa office while taking visa stamp.
2. Visa also is granted on the basis of relevant notifications and circulars as well as the invitation from the government of Bangladesh. In cases of bilateral Agreements or Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with other countries, visa will be issued according to the agreements/MoU. Principle of reciprocity is to be followed for issues that are not covered in visa policy and agreement/MoU.
3. For A2 categories of visa, United Nations and its organizations means WHO, UNDP, FAO, UNFPA, ILO, UNICEF, UNESCO, IMF, World Bank, WFP, IDB, UNCTAD, UNHCR, IOM, UNODC, IAEA, UNIDO etc. International/Multilateral and Regional organization and bilateral development agencies means USAID, JICA, KOICA, JBIC, DFID, CIDA, SIDA, DANIDA, PEACE CORPS, NORAD, FINNIDA, ICDDR, ADB, RED CROSS/RED CRESCENT, BIMSTEC, SAARC, COMMONWEALTH, IFAD, OIC, IRENA, OPCW, ICC, PCA, EU, AFD, SDC, D-8 and other organizations of similar type.
4. Machine Readable Visa (MRV) must be issued in all cases. In case of any emergency situation different method can be prescribed by the Ministry of Home Affairs. When computer program based/ electronically issued visa (e-visa) system will be introduced, visa number has to be mentioned according to program code.
5. Visa issuing authorities have to mention following conditions on the visa label while issuing visas:
 - a) For categories of A1, FA2, B, C, FE1, FE2, FE3, FJ, M, FM, FN1, N2, FP, FPI, R, S, FSR, T, FBN, MT, MA, and RT with “Employment in Bangladesh prohibited”.
 - b) At the time of issuing E1, E2, E3, J, P, PI and N1 category visa, passport of a person arriving with a view to take up employment /work must be stamped with the condition ‘please apply for work permit to BIDA/BEPZA/BEZA/BHTPA/NGO Affairs Bureau/PPA or other competent authorities within 15 (fifteen) working days of first entry into Bangladesh.
6. A person arriving from India and Pakistan with a visa for 90 (Ninety) days or more has to register with the immigration authorities at the port of entry within 14 (fourteen) days of arrival.
7. Foreign nationals arriving from countries other than India and Pakistan will be exempted from such requirement specified in condition no 6.
8. Application for an extension of visa has to be made 15 days before the expiry of the visa. If application is lodged after the expiry date, penalty shall be applicable on ground of overstay.

9. (a) The illegal stay of foreign nationals coming to Bangladesh on valid visas may be regularized subject to the following penalty:
- (i) For the first 15 (fifteen) days of illegal stay, at the rate of 1,000/- (one thousand) Bangladeshi Taka per day;
 - (ii) If the period of illegal stay exceeds 15 (fifteen) days, at the rate of 2,000/- (two thousand) taka per day up to a maximum of 90 (ninety) days; and;
 - (iii) If the period of illegal stay exceeds 90 (ninety) days, a penalty of 3,000/- (three thousand) taka per day may be realized. At the same time, a case may be filed against the foreign national concerned in the relevant court under the Foreigners Act (Act No. 31 of 1946) due to illegal stay. The Additional Inspector General of Police, Special Branch may take necessary measures to file a case under this order.
 - (iv) The fine for illegal stay of foreign citizens of Bangladeshi origin/foreign spouses and children of Bangladeshi citizens may be waived.
 - (v) The fine for illegal stay of foreign students studying may be waived for up to 3 (three) months. However, if the illegal stay exceeds 3 (three) months, a maximum fine of Tk. 3,000 (Taka three thousand) may be realized. If the illegal stay exceeds 6 (six) months condition 9 (a) (iii) will be applied.
- (b) If it is necessary to consider the issue of waiver of fine imposed for illegal stay, the Department of Immigration and Passports may send a proposal with its opinion to the Ministry of Home Affairs in the following cases:
- (i) Physical illness: If the stay is illegal due to physical illness, the Department of Immigration and Passports shall duly examine the application submitted for waiver of the said fine on the basis of a medical certificate issued by the concerned Civil Surgeon or Professor/Associate Professor and send it to the Ministry of Home Affairs along with appropriate recommendations. However, if the illegal stay due to illness exceeds 5 (five) days, a certificate from the hospital authority stating that the person is/was admitted to the hospital must be submitted.
 - (ii) Other reasons: If the stay is illegal due to any other reasonable/credible/well-grounded reason, the said department may send an application for waiver of the fine payable along with a clear and reasonable reason and detailed explanation along with appropriate recommendations to the government/Ministry for consideration.
 - (iii) The above recommendations must be sent to Ministry of Home Affairs under the signature of the Director General or Director of the Department of Immigration.

(c) For a stay of up to 7 (seven) days, the concerned passport holder can leave Bangladesh by appearing at the Department of Immigration and Passports/Immigration Authority at the airport/land port and paying the applicable fine, service charge and visa fee. However, cash cannot be accepted for fine, service charge and visa fee. The concerned passport holder can be allowed to leave Bangladesh if the said amount is deposited in the prescribed code in a scheduled bank of the Government of Bangladesh and the deposit receipt is presented. The period of illegal stay and the amount of fine must be mentioned in the passport.

(d) If someone stays illegally due to unavoidable reasons such as natural disasters, accidents, flight cancellations etc., the period of his stay will not be considered illegal.

10. The Ministry of Home Affairs may consider a note verbale, particularly on humanitarian grounds, when deciding on an overstay fine for a foreign national. While overstay fines are generally realized according to established rules, the MoHA has the authority to consider mitigating circumstances, and a note verbale from the relevant Embassy/ High Commission could be a relevant factor in such a consideration.
11. A visa category cannot be changed after entering Bangladesh, except for a Visa on Arrival (VoA). A VoA may be converted only to the following categories: A1, D, ND, A2, FA2, E1, E2, E3, FE1, FE2, FE3, J, PI, FPI, P, RT, FBN and NVR. A visa conversion fee of US\$200 is applicable only to those who undertake employment. UN passport holders are exempt from the visa conversion fee. Applicants who enter Bangladesh using their national passport shall also be exempt from the visa conversion fee in cases of conversion to the A1, D, ND, A2 and FA2 visa category. For conversion to the E2, E3, J, P, and PI categories, a recommendation letter addressed to the Ministry of Home Affairs must be submitted from BIDA, BEZA, BEPZA, BHTPA, PPA or another competent authority.
12. Particular Nationals will get Visa on Arrival for 30 days (single entry) at the designated port of entry while travel to Bangladesh for some particular reasons given below. The visa issuing/immigration authority will grant VoA after being satisfied on examining the invitation and relevant documents. (Such as hotel reservation, return ticket and proof of finance in card or cash).
 - a) Investors/Development partners travelling to Bangladesh at the invitation of the Government or investment authority;
 - b) Foreigners travelling to Bangladesh from those countries where there is no diplomatic mission of Bangladesh;
 - c) Nationals of Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, China, Japan, South Korea, Brunei, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Qatar, Kuwait, Oman, Bahrain, Egypt, USA, Canada, Brazil, Australia, New Zealand, Russia, Turkey, UK and other European countries travelling to Bangladesh for the purpose of tourism and business;
 - d) Foreign citizen of Bangladeshi origin and their spouse and children;
 - e) Officials of diplomatic mission in Bangladesh and the UN organizations;
 - f) Diplomatic and UN passport holders;
 - g) Foreigners with prior approval from Ministry of Home Affairs;

- h) Transit Visa can be issued up to next connecting flight but not more than 72 hours with charge of 20 USD or equivalent foreign currency;
 - i) The visa issuing/immigration authority will have to keep records regarding issuance VoA and submit monthly Statements to the Ministry of Home Affairs and DIP.
13. All visitors must hold a passport valid for 6 months.
 14. Valid visa of an old passport can be transferred to a new passport upon application with relevant country fees if applicable.
 15. Visa fees will be applicable on the basis of reciprocity or agreement/arrangement/ memorandum of understanding. A, A1, A2, D and ND Visa will be gratis.
 16. In case a report is required for issuance or extension of a visa, the concerned agency (SB/ NSI) shall provide the report within 21 (twenty-one) working days of receiving request from the visa authority. If no report is received within the time specified, visa issuing authority may take appropriate decision taking into consideration that the said agency has no objection on granting or extending the visa. No such opinion from the agency shall be required for a child under 15 (fifteen) years of age.
 17. For the civil and military officials from overseas arriving for specific work and training in the defense service institutions in Bangladesh, the recommendations of Armed Forces Division (AFD) will be accepted instead of the work permit and security clearance. Bangladesh Missions may grant multiple entry visa to those persons and their dependents for additional 1 (one) month along with the full tenure of training with the recommendations from Armed Forces Division.
 18. If any foreign national arriving with the objective of employment or investment or business or education purposes, conceals any information or violates any condition of the visa issued, the appointing /sponsoring organization of that person shall be fined TK 1,00,000/- (one lac) per person for the first time and TK 2,00,000/- (Two lac) for similar and any subsequent violation.
 19. Student visa shall be granted to a foreign student willing to study at the educational institutions which are approved by the Government of Bangladesh.
 20. If a citizen of any country other than a visa prohibited country desires to visit Bangladesh for tourism from a third country, Bangladesh Mission in that particular country after being satisfied, may grant 'T' category visa in favor of the applicant.
 21. Visa fees shall not be refunded if a visa application is declined.
 22. A person arriving from a country which has been declared as public health emergency of international concern by WHO may be required to undergo health screening or additional measures as decided by the competent authority at the designated entry port from time to time.
 23. A2, E1, E2, E3, S, R, PI, FBN visas may be issued with maximum duration for the respective category.

24. For other categories, visa can be granted for any duration up to the maximum approved duration for that specific category considering individual requirements.
25. For granting or extension of visa, Security Clearance means clearance issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs. Police report will imply the report from Special Branch of police.
26. With regard to the conversion and extension of a visa more than the maximum period allowed in the circular, the Ministry of Home Affairs may waive, impose or relax any condition mentioned in the policy.
27. While shooting film/documentary, the foreign journalist must be accompanied by designated representative of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. And he will have to submit 'No objection certificate/clearance from the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting' at the immigration point before leaving the country.
28. NVR can be issued in foreign passports of Bangladeshi origin who have acquired citizenship of any country in the world and foreign citizens of Bangladeshi origin of the second and third generation and their spouse /children and foreign spouse/children of Bangladeshi citizens and foreign investors to facilitate their entry and stay in Bangladesh under the terms and conditions:
 - (1) In the case of Bangladeshi origin who have acquired citizenship of any country in the world, except SAARC countries, and foreign citizens of Bangladeshi origin of the second and third generation and their spouse/children
 - (a) Dual Citizenship Certificate or Bangladeshi MRP/e-Passport/National Identity Card/Online Birth Registration Certificate/Citizenship Certificate of father/mother/husband/wife;
 - (b) Certificate of Naturalization or legal documents from which the foreign citizenship has been obtained;
 - (c) Affidavit given by father/mother/husband/wife in favor of the applicant regarding the child/husband/wife;
 - (d) Marriage certificate (if applicable).
 - (e) Birth certificate (if applicable).
 - (2) In the case of foreign spouse and children of Bangladeshi citizens:
 - (a) Bangladeshi MRP/E-Passport/National Identity Card/Online Birth Registration Certificate/Citizenship Certificate of husband/wife/father/mother;
 - (b) Affidavit of relationship given by father/mother/husband/wife in favor of the foreign child/husband/wife;
 - (c) Marriage certificate (Nikahnama).
 - (d) Birth certificate (for children of Bangladeshi citizens).
 - (e) Police verification is required for the spouse and for children above 15 (fifteen) years.

(3) The NVR facility will remain valid as long as the passport is valid. NVR application fee will be 80 (eighty) US dollars or equivalent.

(4) The NVR shall be issued after proper verification of the certificates submitted with the application. If the applicant has NVR in his old foreign passport, NVR shall be issued in the new foreign passport subject to payment of fees. In case of transfer of NVR to the new passport of the foreign spouse of a citizen of Bangladeshi origin an affidavit by his/her spouse will have to be submitted along with the application.

(5) Foreign Investors will get NVR facility for investment 05(five) millions of US dollars in heavy industry or long-term business in Bangladesh. In that case, a certificate issued by BIDA/BEPZA/BEZA/Investment Authority will have to be submitted along with the application.

(6) In case of issuing NVR in favor of Foreigner of Bangladeshi origin and their spouse/children who have obtained foreign citizenship or permanent residency based on investment, a favorable report from the Bangladesh Financial Intelligence Unit (BFIU) along with the investigating agency will be mandatory.

(7) Machine-readable NVR must be issued in the foreign passport.

29. Dependent family members mean spouse, parents, children, adopted children of principal visa holder/applicant.

30. Validity of a security clearance provided by the Ministry of Home Affairs will be 5 years.

31. If any question is raised regarding visa as well as NVR which is not mentioned in this Visa Policy clearly the Ministry of Home Affairs reserves the right to take any decision including explanation/clarification and cancellation of Visa.

32. (1) The circulars issued previously concerning visa, are hereby repealed:

(2) Upon the repeal of the circulars, all visas issued previously will remain valid until expiry.

33. The Government reserves the right to cancel, modify, amend, or revise any part of this circular or the visa policy at any time, if necessary.

34. This Visa Policy-2026 will come into effect immediately.
