The undersigned is directed to convey the Government's approval of deputation and study leave to Ms. Sabera Tabassum Wahid (ID No. 20704), (Passport No. E00124541), Officer on Special Duty (Senior Assistant Secretary), Ministry of Public Administration to study the course Doctor of Philosophy in Health Economics, University of Queensland, Australia from **01-01-2026 to 31-12-2029** under the following terms and conditions:

- a. She will start her journey toward Australia on a convenient date near 01 January 2026;

- c. She will draw all parts of her pay and allowances in local currency;
- d. All expenses related to this program will be borne by University of Queensland Graduate School from Research Training Program (RTP) Scholarship;
- e. **Her deputation period is from 01-01-2026 to 30-10-2028;**
- f. **Duration of her study leave (on half average pay) is from 01.11.2028 to 31.12.2029;**
- g. She will not be allowed to stay abroad for more than the approved period;
- h. She will be ineligible to apply for permanent residency and citizenship while studying abroad;
- i. The provision of Rule 34 of BSR (Part-1) and provision of Appendix V and Rule 194 of BSR (Part-1) will be applicable in connection with this approval;
- j. All terms and conditions of the Public Administration Training and Higher Education Policy-2023 and other related Rules and Regulations for training/studying abroad will be applicable;
- k. She must submit a report to the Career Planning-2 Section of the Ministry of Public Administration within five days after her return from/completion of the course.

2. This order is issued with the approval of the competent authority.


