The idea that China establishes the Institute of South-South Cooperation and Development (ISSCAD) of Peking University was initiated and announced by Chinese President XI Jinping during the High-Level Roundtable on South-South Cooperation at the 70th Anniversary Celebration of the United Nations in New York on September 26, 2015. The Institute offers one-year master's and three-year doctoral programs for mid-to-senior-level administrators or researchers from governments, academic institutions, news media, and non-governmental organizations in developing countries.

resource development and economic and social progress in the People's Republic of Bangladesh, The Institute of South-South Cooperation and Development at Peking University plans to enroll candidates from developing countries for the 2026 Master Program in Public Administration (National Development) (1-year program) and candidates for 2026 Doctoral Program in National Development Studies (3-year program).

It's my honor to invite 1-3 eligible applicants include government officials from Bangladesh (at division head level or above), heads of departments or senior administrative personnel of academic institutions, and mid-to-senior management professionals in related fields to pursue full-time English-taught master's or doctoral degree programs in China. Applicants for the master's program must hold a bachelor's degree, while doctoral applicants must possess a master's degree, along with a specified number of years of work experience in relevant fields to ensure their timely and comprehensive understanding of the curriculum.
