The undersigned is directed to convey the Government's approval of deputation to Mr. Shahriar Jamil (ID No.16932), (Passport No. E00154849) Deputy Secretary (Officer on Special Duty-Study Deputation), Ministry of Public Administration to study PhD in Economics at Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi, India from **23.07.2026 to 22.07.2027** under the following terms and conditions:

- a) He will start his journey toward the India on a convenient date near 23 July 2026;
- b) The approved period of this program and the time spent for travel and transit will be treated as on duty;
- c) He will draw all parts of his pay and allowances in local currency;
- d) The Reserve Bank of India under SAARCFINANCE Scholarship will bear all expenses for the study of the course. The participant must abide by the conditions of the Scholarship Program ;
- e) **The Duration of his PhD course will be from 23.07.2026 to 22.07.2031 and the deputation period for the 1st year of the program is from 23.07.2026 to 22.07.2027;**
- f) The Deputation period will be renewed each year up to yearly completion of the PhD program upon receiving the progress report from the supervisor;
- g) He will not be allowed to stay abroad beyond the approved period;
- h) He will be ineligible to apply for permanent residency and citizenship while studying abroad;
- i) The provision of Rule 34 of BSR (part-1) will be applicable in connection with this approval;
- j) He will have to send a progress report to the Career Planning-2 Section every year from the concerned research supervisor;
- k) He will submit a report to the Career Planning-2 Section of the Ministry of Public Administration within five days of his return from completing the course;
- l) All terms and conditions of Public Administration and Higher Education Policy-2023 and other related Rules and Regulations for training/studying abroad will be applicable.
