- Success stories and testimonials.
- Challenges encountered and solutions adopted.

3. Sustainability and Scalability:

- Potential for replication or expansion.
- Strategies for ensuring long-term sustainability.



4. Supporting Proof Materials:

- Photos, videos, or other multimedia documents (optional but encouraged).
- Additional documentation or evidence supporting the practice.

Selection Criteria

Submissions will be evaluated on the basis of:

- Relevance: alignment with GCED principles and goals.
- Innovation: creativity and originality of the approach.
- Impact: demonstrated positive outcomes and effectiveness.
- Sustainability: potential for long-term viability and scalability.
- Documentation: clarity and thoroughness of the submission.
