

# Public Policy Process of Bangladesh: Rhetoric or Pre-condition for Development?

**Abstract** - The quality of public policy management largely determines the quality of governance of a country as the former distributes collective and authoritative values in the society. Being predominantly political, policy process depends more on the prevalent role structure and the rules of the game of the policy environment contrary to rational economic process where information processing capacity takes the lead. Although the role structure and rules of the game are defined by the legal framework, customary practices and the institutional framework, actual policy outcome often dictates the bargaining capacity of the actors involved in three distinct stages of the policy process: policy formulation, implementation and evaluation.
