NOTIFICATIONS.

No. 2558J.—16th June 1952.—In exercise of the power conferred by section 14 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898), the Governor is pleased to confer upon Maung Shwe Prue and Babu Hementa Prasad Talukdar, Welfare Officers of the Chittagong Hill-tracts, the powers of a Magistrate of the third class in the Chittagong Hill-tracts, for a period of three years, with effect from the 22nd June 1952, in respect to such criminal cases as may be made over to them by their respective Subdivisional Magistrates of the Chittagong Hill-tracts for disposal.
