Training on “Guidelines on Inspection Checklist”

A three-day training on “Guidelines on Inspection Checklist” was successfully conducted at NOSHTRI from January 26 to January 28 under the close supervision of JIG of NOSHTRI, Md. Bulbul Ahmed. Thirty officials from various DIFE district offices attended the program.

The training aimed to enhance participants' understanding of each section of the inspection checklist and the evaluation system, enabling them to apply it effectively during inspections and reporting.

As part of the training, participants were divided into three groups, each assigned to visit a different factory. Using the inspection checklist, they conducted assessments and recorded their observations. After the visits, each group presented its findings to the trainers and fellow participants, who provided feedback on their performance.

TOT on Formation and Responsibilities of Safety Committee

According to Section 90(a) of the Bangladesh Labour Act 2006, factories with 50 or more workers must establish a safety committee as per the prescribed rules. To provide in-depth training on this law, a three-day program titled “TOT on Formation and Responsibilities of Safety Committee” was inaugurated on February 4, 2025, by the Honorable JIG of NOSHTRI, Mr. Md. Bulbul Ahmed. The training continued until February 6, 2025, and was attended by 30 (thirty) officers from various DIFE district offices. In the future, these participants will conduct training sessions for safety committee members in factories and establishments within their jurisdictions.

In addition to on-campus training, NOSHTRI has introduced on-site training programs. As part of its ongoing initiatives, NOSHTRI has launched first aid training for first aid team members as well as other employees in various labor-intensive factories across the country. This initiative will enhance workers' first aid skills and improves their ability to respond effectively during emergencies.

On February 6, 2025, NOSHTRI, with support from DIFE, Narayanganj, conducted a half-day “First Aid” training session at Fakir Knitwears Limited, Kayempur, Fatullah, Narayanganj. The session was led by Dr. Md. Soaib Hossen, Assistant Inspector General (Health), NOSHTRI as the resource person, under the guidance of the Honorable JIG of NOSHTRI, Mr. Md. Bulbul Ahmed who was the course adviser of the training program. Participants engaged in both theoretical and practical training.

Inauguration Program: “DIFE-to-DIFE Training” on “Ergonomics” and “Pressure Vessel”

The two-day “DIFE-to-DIFE Training” program on “Ergonomics” and “Pressure Vessel” (held on February 11–12, 2025) was inaugurated by Mr. Md. Bulbul Ahmed, JIG of NOSHTRI, on February 11. Mr. Ole R. Justesen, Sector Counsellor at the Embassy of Denmark in Dhaka, along with experts from the Danish Working Environment Authority (DWEA) and NOSHTRI officials, joined the event.

A total of 57 (fifty-seven) officials from DIFE participated, including 40 (forty) training participants and 17 (seventeen) OSH team members. The speakers emphasized the importance of reflecting training efficiency in inspectors' reports to employers.

Training on "Ergonomics" and "Pressure Vessel"



Training Session is going on

Two separate five-day training programs (February 9–13, 2025) on "Ergonomics" and "Pressure Vessels," jointly organized by DIFE and DWEA, was inaugurated by Honorable JIG NOSHTRI, Md Bulbul Ahmed, on February 9, 2025. During the program, the OSH Team on Pressure Vessel, consisting of eight members, conducted a two-day training (February 11–12) for 20 (twenty) DIFE officials. Similarly, the OSH Team on Ergonomics, with nine members, led a two-day training (February 11–12) for another 20 (twenty) DIFE officials.

The Ergonomics training helped inspectors assess whether workplace furniture and equipment are suitable for workers' physical conditions. Meanwhile, the Pressure Vessel training provided inspectors with foundational knowledge on different types of pressure vessels, enabling them to monitor worker safety more effectively.

"First Aid Training" at Azim and Son (Pvt.) Ltd., Indira Road, Dhaka

A half-day "Training on First Aid" was held at Azim and Son (Pvt.) Ltd., 36A Indira Road, Dhaka, on February 13, 2025. The event was organized by NOSHTRI with support from DIFE, Dhaka, and attended by 40 (forty) employees and workers of the said factory.

The course adviser of this training was the Honorable JIG of NOSHTRI, while the DIG (Finance and Planning) of NOSHTRI served as the course director. Md. Nosibul Momin, LIG of NOSHTRI, coordinated the program. Dr. Lutfun Nahar, Assistant Inspector General (Health) of DIFE, Dhaka, conducted the training as the resource person. The session covered an introduction to basic first aid, first aid for injuries and emergency response.

Soaib Hossen, Assistant Inspector General (Health), NOSHTRI, was the resource person and led both theoretical and practical sessions on introduction of basic first aid, basic first aid in common injuries and in emergencies.

Training on "Crane & Other Lifting Machines".

A five-day training program on "Crane & Other Lifting Machines" jointly organized by DIFE and the Danish Working Environment Authority (DWEA) was successfully completed at NOSHTRI from February 16–20, 2025. The program included 28 (twenty-eight) participants—eight members of the OSH Team for Crane Safety and 20 (twenty) DIFE officers.

As part of the program, the OSH team conducted a two-day (February 18–19) DIFE-to-DIFE training on crane and other lifting machines' safety for DIFE officials. A Danish expert served as the mentor, observing each session throughout the training. Participants enhanced their knowledge of various crane types, hazard identification, risk management, accident prevention, rigging systems, crane maintenance, and relevant laws and regulations. Following the DIFE-to-DIFE training, some materials were revised based on participant feedback and guidance from the Danish expert.

Training on "Accident Prevention"

A five-day training program, "Accident Prevention" (February 16–20, 2025), was successfully conducted at NOSHTRI. Organized jointly by DIFE and the Danish Working Environment Authority (DWEA), the program contained eight OSH team members from the Accident Prevention unit and 20 (twenty) DIFE officials from various districts. On February 18–19, OSH team members led a DIFE-to-DIFE training session on accident prevention for the 20 (twenty) DIFE officers. A Danish expert, serving as the trainer, monitored all sessions throughout the program. The training advanced participants' knowledge of workplace accident prevention and investigation. At the end of the DIFE-to-DIFE session, participants evaluated the program and provided feedback.

"Training on First Aid" at Bangladesh-India Friendship Power Co. (Pvt) Ltd., Rampal, Bagerhat

A half-day first aid training was staged on February 26, 2025, at Bangladesh-India Friendship Power Co. (Pvt) Ltd. in Sagamari, Katakhal, Rajnagar, Rampal, Bagerhat. Organized by NOSHTRI with support from DIFE, Khulna, the session was attended by employees and workers of the company.

Honorable JIG of NOSHTRI was the course adviser, while Dr. Md. Soail Hossen, AIG (Health) of NOSHTRI, was both the course director and resource person. Md. Suman Ali, Labour Inspector (Health) at NOSHTRI, coordinated the training. The resource person conducted the theoretical as well as practical session on introduction of basic first aid, basic first aid in injuries and emergencies.

The training aimed to equip participants with research skills, particularly in writing research proposals. Participants were divided into six teams of four members each. After the sessions, each team proposed a research topic with objectives. Before the next session, participants can share questions, feedback, and experiences via the WhatsApp group "Research Methodology Training Batch," which will be monitored by the resource person. He will stay engaged with each team and expects meaningful progress in their research work.

"Training on First Aid" at SQ Celsius Limited, Bhaluka, Mymensingh.
