Newsbrief

The Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Myanmar, Tom Andrews, called on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the latter's office in Dhaka the day before yesterday. The UN Envoy lauded the leadership of the Chief Adviser for keeping the Rohingya issue at the forefront of the international agenda, according to a press release issued by the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday. Andrews recalled the successful initiative of the Chief Adviser to convene a UN International Conference on the Rohingyas, which will be held on 30th September at the UN headquarters in the New York. The Chief Adviser expressed the hope that the UN Conference will provide concrete pathways to the resolution of this prolonged crisis. The Chief Adviser also said that the recent cut in financial support to the Rohingyas sheltered in Bangladesh is taking its toll on the provision of essential services, including health and education.

Pakistan's Federal Commerce Minister Jam Kamal Khan said that a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Bangladesh and Pakistan will be signed tomorrow to establish a Joint Working Group (JWG) aimed at strengthening bilateral trade relations. The Pakistan's Commerce Minister said this while speaking at a views-sharing meeting with entrepreneurs and businessmen in Chattogram yesterday. Addressing the event at the Chattogram Chamber of Commerce and Industry conference room, Commerce Adviser Sheikh Bashir Uddin said, the government has been relentlessly working to build ties with as many countries as possible to diversify business opportunities and expand trade capacity. The Adviser expressed optimism that local businessmen and entrepreneurs would be able to elevate current trade and investment growth to new heights through enhanced capabilities.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma called upon everyone to be inspired by patriotism and human welfare and to actively engage in virtuous deeds. The Adviser made this call at the religious ceremony in observance of the weekly rites for Babu Padmaranjan Chakma in the Mahajanpara of Khagrachari yesterday. Later, the Adviser laid foundation stone of a hostel at Kamalchhari Pilot High School of the district.

The interim government has issued a strong warning regarding the broadcasting of statements by Awami League leader Sheikh Hasina, who is a fugitive accused in crimes against humanity cases. The Chief Adviser's Press Wing issued a statement in this regard yesterday. Moreover, in December last year, the International Crimes Tribunal banned the broadcasting of the former dictator's statements inciting hatred, it added.

The National Identity Card service has been inaugurated at the Bangladesh Embassy in Tokyo. Senior Secretary of the Election Commission Akhtar Ahmed inaugurated the programme in the hall room of the embassy yesterday.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner Sheikh Mohammad Sajjad Ali said, all should work together to make the next national election free and fair. The DMP Commissioner said this while addressing at the 42nd anniversary of Bangladesh Crime Reporters Association in Dhaka yesterday.
