Newsbrief

President Mohammed Shahabuddin and Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus paid rich tributes to the martyrs of the historic Language Movement by placing wreaths at the Central Shaheed Minar marking 'Amar Ekushey'—the International Mother Language Day and Shaheed Dibosh. The President arrived at the Shaheed Minar exactly at 11:59pm and placed a wreath as the clock struck 00:01. Then the Chief Adviser paid rich tributes to the martyrs of the historic Language Movement, marking the Amar Ekushey and the International Mother Language Day. The Chief Adviser paid homage by placing a wreath at the Central Shaheed Minar in the capital at 12:02 am today. The Chief Adviser stood in solemn silence for some time as a mark of profound respect to the memories of the Language Heroes.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged the countrymen to remain alert to resist come back of fascists. The Chief Adviser said this in a video message yesterday at the inaugural ceremony of the '7th National Comdeca' under the management of Bangladesh Scouts at National Scout Training Centre-2 in the hard point of Sirajganj town protection embankment.

Some families of martyrs in the July uprising met Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, they discussed various issues including the trial of those responsible for the violence during the July Uprising, the creation of the July Uprising Directorate, and the recognition and state honours for the families of the martyrs and the injured. The Chief Adviser listened to the expectations of the martyrs' families and highlighted the ongoing activities of the government as well as its future plans.

The Chief Adviser urged Uruguay to build on the people-to-people connectivity through sports, leading to increase bilateral engagements in different fields, including trade and business cooperation. The Chief Adviser made the call when the non-resident Uruguay Ambassador to Bangladesh, Alberto A. Guani, paid a courtesy call on him at the State Guest House Jamuna, Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the Bangladesh Bank governor and the authorities concerned to bring those involved in looting money from banks to justice as soon as possible. The Chief Adviser gave the directives at a meeting on 'Bangladesh Economy: Recent Challenges and Future Way Forward' at the Chief Adviser's Office in Tejgaon area yesterday.

The Chief Adviser said, the country's young generation wants to lead the world apart from building a new Bangladesh as he conferred Ekushey Padak-2025 on the recipients. The Chief Adviser said this at the award distribution function at Osmani Memorial Auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Earlier, the Chief Adviser paid tribute to people of all languages in the world, including Bangla, on the occasion of the great Martyrs' Day and the International Mother Language Day-2025 to be observed today. The Chief Adviser said this in a message on the day.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said that smooth supply chain of commodities would be ensured during the upcoming holy Month of Ramadan so that the consumers need not to suffer. The Finance Adviser said this while replying to queries of reporters after chairing two separate meetings on the Advisers Council Committees on Economic Affairs and Government Purchase held at the Cabinet Division Conference Room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, both Dhaka and Delhi agreed to establish good working relations by addressing the remaining challenges. The Adviser told reporters at the Foreign Ministry yesterday, referring to his recent meeting with Indian External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar in Muscat, Oman.

Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, the government has started working to enact a road safety law by 2027. The Adviser made this remark on Wednesday night at the Global Ministerial Conference on Road Safety held in Marrakesh, Morocco from February 18-20, according to a press release yesterday.

Bangladesh Ambassador to Mexico Mushfiqul Fazal Ansari said, the Embassy would actively facilitate employment opportunities for skilled Bangladeshi professionals in Mexico's labor market, particularly in the fields of IT, agriculture, engineering, and other specialized sectors. The Ambassador made the remarks at a discussion event titled "Meet the Ambassador", organized by the Bangladesh Embassy in Mexico City on Sunday, according to a message received yesterday.

The interim government termed the statement by India's Ministry of External Affairs regarding the incident at Dhanmondi 32 "unexpected and unwarranted," asserting that it pertains to Bangladesh's internal affairs. Foreign Ministry Spokesperson Mohammad Rafiqul Alam said this at a media briefing at the Ministry in the capital yesterday.

A command centre, established to monitor intensively the country's law and order situation started its works from yesterday. The Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said this at a press briefing, held at Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. Bangladesh and China will work closer than ever to forge a comprehensive strategic cooperative partnership so that the 50th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations is visibly marked with the people-to-people exchanges in various areas of cooperation. Bangladesh Ambassador to China Md. Nazmul Islam and Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs Ambassador Sun Weidong reiterated their countries' commitment in a meeting held at the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Beijing yesterday.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Dr. Ali Riaz said, national election in December this year appeared possible as political parties are committed to undertake the reform process. Dr. Ali Riaz told BSS in an exclusive interview in Dhaka yesterday.
