Newsbrief

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the measures will be taken as per the recommendations of the committee formed to probe the Gopalganj incident. The Adviser said this while speaking to journalists after visiting the Third Terminal of the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka yesterday. Replying to a question about the postmortem of the people who died in the Gopalganj incident the Adviser said, the postmortem of a man who died later in Dhaka is being conducted while the bodies of others were taken away earlier.

Earlier, Home Adviser said, workers are the main driving force of the country's economic development and the government has taken effective steps to fulfill all of their reasonable demands and needs. The Adviser said this while addressing a workers' rally organized in Savar yesterday marking the July Uprising. He also said, the government has been working to remove the dissatisfaction of workers according to the Labour Law 2006.

Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said, the Interim Government sincerely believes that a sustainable peace and development in the CHT is possible if all parties work together to implement the peace accord. The Adviser said this at the meeting of the CHT Peace Accord Implementation and Monitoring Committee at Rangamati Development Board Rest House in Rangamati yesterday. The Adviser termed this meeting as an important step towards peace, security and development of the people of CHT areas.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, Bangladesh has been advancing towards development due to the contributions of the working class of people as they are the main driving force of the country's development. The Adviser said this while addressing a mammoth workers rally at Genda Balurmath near Savar bus stand in Savar yesterday. The Ministry of Labour and Employment organized the rally as part of the 'July Punarjagoron Anusthanmala-2025'.

Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser (CA) Shafiqul Alam said that election would be held in the country within the timeframe, set by Chief Adviser to the Interim Government Professor Muhammad Yunus. The Press Secretary made this remark while responding to questions from journalists after attending the 'TEDx Comilla University' event in Cumilla yesterday. The event was held at the Mainamoti auditorium of the Bangladesh Academy for Rural Development at Kotbari in Cumilla.

The Government of Bangladesh has signed a three-year Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) to field a mission in the country aimed at supporting the promotion and protection of human rights. The Chief Adviser's Press Wing issued a press statement in this regard yesterday.

Bangladesh Army has denied allegations circulating on social media that it provided transport support to a political party, describing the claims as completely false, misleading and a deliberate attempt to tarnish the image of the military. In a statement issued yesterday, the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) clarified that the claim involving buses marked with the Army's logo being used for political activities is baseless and motivated by ill intent.

Bangladesh and Japan further strengthened their cultural ties through a joint art exhibition inaugurated at the Embassy of Japan in Dhaka, reflecting the deepening bilateral cooperation in arts and culture. The exhibition, titled 'Origins of Vision,' has been jointly organized by HerNet Fine Arts and the Embassy of Japan as part of the embassy's ongoing commitment to fostering artistic exchanges between the two countries, according to a press release yesterday.
