Newsbrief

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said, the government is trying to create a national single window so that businessmen get all information from one place. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at the launch of the 6th edition of Banking Almanac-2023 yesterday at the CIRDAP Auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, late A.F. Hassan Ariff was a perfect Lawyer whose contributions to establishing environmental justice, in addition to his professional responsibilities, remained unparalleled. The Adviser made the remarks while delivering a memorial speech after paying tribute to late A.F. Hassan Ariff, Adviser to the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism and the Ministry of Land, at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Nahid Islam urged all involved in the transport sector to work together to ensure road safety in the country. The Adviser made the call while speaking at the National Dialogue on Institutional Management and Structural Reforms to establish discipline in the road transport sector, organized by the Road Safety Foundation at the Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB) in Dhaka yesterday.

The Food Adviser said this while briefing the media personnel after a views exchange meeting with the Deputy Commissioners and District Food Controllers of Rajshahi Division at Sirajganj circuit house yesterday.

Indian media outlets' reports claiming 2200 incidents of violence occurred against Hindus in 2024 is a misleading and highly exaggerated ones, the chief adviser's press wing said. Several Indian media outlets, including India Today, Anandabazar, citing the country's Ministry of External Affairs, on Friday reported that in Bangladesh, 47 incidents of violence against Hindus occurred in the year 2022, 302 in 2023, and 2,200 in 2024. The Press wing said this in a statement posted on its verified Facebook page - CA Press Wing Facts - yesterday.


