Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, social business can change not only Bangladesh but the whole world. The Chief Adviser said social business is the only right way to ensure healthcare for everyone in the world and through this it is quite possible to address the challenges of healthcare sector. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while addressing the inauguration session of the programs of the two-day Social Business Day at the Samajik Convention Centre in Zirabo, Savar yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed urged protesting National Board of Revenue (NBR) officials to withdraw their movement and return to work. Following a two-and-a-half-hour meeting at the Finance Ministry, both the Adviser expressed optimism about resolving the issue soon.

Law Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Ministry is going to withdraw at least 20,000 false and politically motivated cases in the next six months, freeing the implicated people from all the stigmas and sufferings once and for all. The Adviser said this at a programme in the capital yesterday.

Home Affairs and Agriculture Adviser Lt. Gen. Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (retd) hoped that people of all religions in Bangladesh will observe their religious ceremonies without fear or hesitation, emphasizing that the current government will extend full support to ensure such freedoms. Speaking as the chief guest at the inauguration of the traditional Dhamrai Rath Jatra festival yesterday, organized by the Jashomadhav Temple Management Committee, the Adviser highlighted the substantial improvements in the law and order situation in the country.

Industries Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said that the government is working to increase the paper production capacity of Karnaphuli Paper Mills Limited (KPML). He expressed hope that the factory will become a profitable enterprise. The Adviser made these remarks as the chief guest in a meeting with KPML officials at the KPML conference room in Kaptai Upazila of Rangamati yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives and Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain emphasized the government's efforts to channel Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds into sports sponsorship. The Adviser told the inauguration function of the Mymensingh Divisional Tennis Competition-2025 at national Tennis complex in the capital yesterday as the chief guest.

A loan agreement was signed today for the project titled "Construction of Dual Gauge Double Line between Joydebpur-Ishurdi Section Project (I)" under the 2nd batch of the 46th Japanese ODA Loan Package between Bangladesh and Japan. The 'Loan Agreement' was signed on behalf of the Government of Bangladesh by Md. Shahriar Kader Siddiky, Secretary, Economic Relations Division, while Ichiguchi Tomohide, Chief Representative of the JICA Office in Bangladesh, signed the loan agreement on behalf of the Government of Japan in the NEC-2 conference room of the Economic Relations Division in Dhaka yesterday.

Bangladesh urged all to refrain from reacting to any matter disregarding the facts and ground realities, stressing that the country remains firmly committed to safeguarding the rights of all communities, including the protection of worship places. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs said this in a media release yesterday.
