Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has extended his heartfelt greetings to the Muslim Ummah, including the countrymen, on the occasion of the holy Eid-e-Miladunnabi, to be observed today commemorating the birth and death of the greatest human being, Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) the last Prophet and Messenger of the world. The Chief Adviser said this in Message yesterday. The Chief Adviser noted that the Prophet's (PBUH) extraordinary qualities - his unwavering devotion to Allah, noble character and boundless compassion - made his life 'Uswatun Hasanah', or 'A Beautiful Example' in the Holy Quran. The timeless ideals and teachings of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) will continue to guide humanity across all ages and generations towards the path of salvation, The Chief Adviser added.

Chief Justice Dr Syed Refaat Ahmed yesterday said, Prophet Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) had set the great example of freedom of humanity, equality and justice, which nowadays are very much relevant to people. The Chief Justice made the remarks in a message issued on the occasion of the holy Eid-e-Miladunnabi, marking the day of the birth and death of Prophet Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH).

Health and Family Welfare Adviser Nurjahan Begum urged doctors to refrain from political involvement and prioritize their responsibilities as healthcare providers. She also called on doctors to remain humane, transparent, accountable and honest while performing their duties. The Adviser made the remarks during a meeting with the hospital's executive committee, teachers, doctors, nurses and officials in the conference room after visiting Chattogram Ma-O-Shishu Hospital yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter lauded scientists for their contribution in the country's fisheries sector. The Adviser said while speaking as the chief guest at the inauguration of three-day third International Conference for Sustainable Fisheries organized by the Faculty of Fisheries Science at the Central Auditorium of Sylhet Agricultural University. The conference was organized with the aim of developing sustainable fisheries management and research, exchanging innovative technologies and increasing coordination among stakeholders.

Bangladesh has sent urgent humanitarian aid to Afghanistan following a powerful earthquake that struck the eastern part of the country on August 31, killing more than 2,200 people and injuring over 3,600 others. The disaster has also left over 8,000 homes completely destroyed, causing a severe humanitarian crisis in the affected regions. In response to the tragedy, a Bangladesh Air Force transport aircraft departed for Kabul yesterday under the directive of the Chief Adviser, according to an Inter-Services Public Relations press release.

Government pledged of taking immediate and stern action against those responsible for desecration of the grave and the vile torching of the body of Nurul Haque Molla, also known as Nura Pagla, in Goalondo. The government issued a statement over the incident yesterday.
