Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, the government is actively working to increase manpower in Bangladesh's missions abroad, particularly at consulate general offices, to ensure better services for millions of expatriates. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a discussion marking Foreign Service Day-2025 at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday. The Adviser said, around 80 percent of the challenges faced by Bangladeshi expatriate workers stem from domestic processes before their migration, while the remaining 20 percent occur in destination countries.

Liberation War Affairs Adviser Farooq E Azam Bir Pratik said, freedom fighter Dr. Zafrullah Chowdhury did never compromise on the issue of independence and sovereignty of Bangladesh. Mentioning that Dr. Zafrullah Chowdhury had inspired the youth Farooq E Azam said, the current interim government is working upholding the spirit of Zafrullah Chowdhury. The Adviser said this while speaking as chief guest at a memorial meeting marking the second death anniversary of freedom fighter Dr. Zafrullah Chowdhury at July Smrity Memorial Hall of Chattogram Press Club yesterday. Chattogram Citizens' Forum, a new social organization of Chattogram, was also inaugurated at the programme.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan underscored the deep connection between cultural preservation and sustainable development. The Adviser praised Maheen Khan's commitment to empowering local artisans and advocating for eco-friendly practices within traditional textile crafts. She made the remarks while speaking at the inauguration of Maheen Khan's much-anticipated Baishakhi Festival and the exhibition 'Crafting the Many Threads of Cultural Textiles' at the Edgewater Gallery in the capital's Gulshan area yesterday. She also stressed the need for safeguarding these traditions and promoting their sustainable growth.

A European Union (EU) delegation headed by its Ambassador and Head of Delegation in Bangladesh Michael Miller paid a courtesy call on Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma in Nilachal, Bandarban yesterday. In the public notice, the Commission sought reliable information and testimony regarding the unprecedented and gruesome BDR carnage.

The discussion between Pakistani and Bangladeshi Foreign Secretaries in Dhaka on Thursday was the first of its kind in 15 years and reflected a shared resolve to revitalise bilateral engagement, the Pakistan Foreign Ministry said this in a statement yesterday. Both sides emphasised the importance of maintaining momentum through regular institutional dialogue, early finalisation of pending agreements and enhanced cooperation in trade, agriculture, education and connectivity, the Pakistani statement read.

The body of a Bangladeshi youth, who was shot and later died in Indian custody after being injured by the Indian Border Security Force (BSF) near the Singimari border in Lalmonirhat's Hatibandha upazila, was handed over to Bangladeshi authorities on Thursday.
