Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus today paid glowing tributes to the Armed Forces martyrs, who made supreme sacrifices during the War of Liberation in 1971, on the occasion of the Armed Forces Day. The Chief Adviser paid the homage by placing a wreath at the altar of Shikha Anirban at Dhaka Cantonment, according to the Chief Adviser's Press Wing. Yesterday, on the occasion of the Armed Forces Day, Chief Adviser Prof. Muhammad Yunus issued a messages yesterday.

The interim government gave final approval to the draft of Supreme Court Secretariat Ordinance 2025 to establish a separate secretariat of the apex court aiming to ensuring the full independence of the judiciary. The approval came from a meeting of the Council of Advisers held with Chief Adviser Professor Mohammad Yunus in the chair at his Office in the capital's Tejgaon area yesterday.

The government is thinking about going to the International Criminal Court (ICC) for bringing back fugitive convicts ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and former Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal from India. Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Prof. Dr Asif Nazrul told a press conference at Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday.

Bangladesh called for stronger collective action among Colombo Security Conclave (CSC) member states to confront cyber security, misinformation and disinformation challenges. National Security Adviser Dr Khalilur Rahman made the remarks while delivering Bangladesh's country statement at the seventh meeting of National Security Advisers of the CSC held in New Delhi yesterday.

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court reinstated the caretaker government system, allowing civil appeals filed in this connection. The revived caretaker government provisions, however, can operate in future. The Appellate Division full bench headed by Chief Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed pronounced the short judgment yesterday.

Attorney General Md. Asaduzzaman said, the Supreme Court's historic verdict restoring the non-party caretaker government system marks the beginning of what he described as a 'journey on democratic highway' for the country. The Attorney General said this while talking to journalists on the court premises after the judgment yesterday.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner SM Sazzat Ali has warned that those involved in acts of sabotage-such as crude bomb explosions and arson attacks, will be declared undesirable in Dhaka city and brought under the law. Speaking at the DMP's monthly crime review meeting at Rajarbagh Police Lines yesterday, he emphasized strict impartiality by police members during the upcoming national elections.

The government has appointed a global Ambassador for the prosecution team of the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT). The Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs appointed Bangladeshi origin British lawyer Barrister Muhammad Saif Uddin Khaled as the global Ambassador, who will work as the ICT prosecution's international spokesperson. Apart from this, Bangladeshi origin British lawyer Afzal Sami Syed-Ali has been appointed as the special prosecutorial Adviser of the ICT chief prosecutor. A press release from the ICT Chief Prosecutor's Office said this yesterday.
