Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has directed the authorities concerned to observe a weeklong fire safety preparedness across the country to ensure fire readiness in all public and private establishments. The Chief Adviser gave the instruction at an Advisory Council meeting held at the Chief Adviser's Office in Dhaka yesterday. The government gave final approval to the Representation of the People (Amendment) Ordinance, 2025 (RPO) having provisions for introducing 'No' vote and scrapping the clause related to the use of Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) in the elections. The Council of Advisers gave the approval in the meeting.

Pakistan High Commissioner in Dhaka Imran Haider paid his maiden courtesy call on Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Dhaka yesterday. During the call on, both sides noted with appreciation the recent engagements and exchange of high-level Ministerial visits between the two countries, including the visit of the Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister to Bangladesh in August 2025, according to Foreign Ministry press release.

Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) Managing Director and Chief Editor Mahbub Morshed presented two BSS publications-'Rokter Akkhore Lekha: July Protibedon' and 'Written in Blood Letter: July Reports' to Chief Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed. The BSS Chief Editor handed over the two compilations of BSS stories to the chief justice (CJ) at his office at the Supreme Court in the capital yesterday.

Attorney General (AG) Md. Asaduzzaman yesterday said that the prosecution has proved beyond doubt the charges brought in the crimes against humanity case against three, including ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, over atrocities committed during the July-August Mass Uprising. Delivering his closing argument as the state's Chief legal officer before the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT)-1, headed by Justice Golam Mortuza Mojumder, the attorney general said that the prosecution has presented documentary, oral and circumstantial evidence to prove the case.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Yao Wen said, China is working actively to open its market for Bangladeshi agricultural products such as jackfruit and guava, following the successful entry of fresh Bangladeshi mangoes earlier this year. The Ambassador made the remarks while addressing the opening ceremony of the Bangladesh-China Green Textile Expo 2025 at the International Convention City Bashundhara in the capital yesterday.

German Ambassador to Bangladesh Dr Rüdiger Lotz said, the upcoming national election is a major initiative towards the path of democracy for Bangladesh. The Ambassador made the remarks while speaking to journalists after coming out of a meeting with Chief Election Commissioner A M M Nasir Uddin Election Bhaban at Agargaon in the capital yesterday.

Senior Secretary of the Ministry of Land ASM Saleh Ahmed said that automation of land services is a timely and significant step toward building a modern, transparent and citizen-friendly land administration system. The Senior Secretary made the remarks at a seminar titled 'Technohaven Co Ltd is the Project Management Consultant for the Land Management Automation Project' held at the Ministry yesterday. The Senior Secretary also said, the Land Management Automation Project will ensure good governance, transparency and accountability in land services while reducing corruption and harassment.
