### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged the countrymen to bear the message of Eid-ul-Fitr in mind to move the nation forward and establish peace in the country. The Chief Adviser made the urges while exchanging Eid greetings with dignitaries from different walks at his Office in Tejgaon in the yesterday.

Extending greetings to the countrymen on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged all to nourish closeness and unity with each other to build a new Bangladesh. The Chief Adviser said this in his brief speech prior to offering prayers at Eid Jamaat at the Jatiya Eidgah ground in the capital yesterday.

The holy Eid-ul-Fitr was yesterday celebrated in festive mood with due dignity in the capital and elsewhere across the country. The main Eid congregation was held at the National Eidgah Maidan in Dhaka. Chief Adviser to the Interim Government Professor Muhammad Yunus offered the holy Eid-ul-Fitr prayers at the National Eidgah Maidan, where diplomats and dignitaries attended the Eid Jamaat.

Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi greeted Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus and the people of Bangladesh on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr. The Indian Prime Minister wrote this in a message sent to Chief Adviser. The message was received in Dhaka yesterday.

Prime Minister of Pakistan Shehbaz Sharif called Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus over phone to exchange Eid greetings. He also invited the Chief Adviser to visit Pakistan at a convenient time in the coming months, Chief Adviser's Press Wing confirmed yesterday.

Home Affairs Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury yesterday visited the Rajarbag Police Lines on the occasion of the Eid-ul-Fitr. The Adviser exchanged greetings with the members of the police who are performing their duties to ensure a safe Eid celebration for the people by sacrificing their own enjoyment.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam exchanged Eid greeting with the family members of Sumaiya Akther, a martyr of July Uprising, at Shiddhirganj in Narayanganj yesterday. The Adviser inquired about the wellbeing of the family members and handed over Eid gifts to them. Mahfuj Alam said, many people like Sumaiya were killed brutally by the fascist. The present interim government is working to bring the murderers to justice, he added.

Earlier, the Information and Broadcasting Adviser offered Eid prayers at the main Eid Jamaat at the National Eidgah yesterday. After the Eid prayers, he exchanged greetings with the devotees.

Thousands of people from all classes and professions joined the Eid procession in the tradition of the Bengal Sultanate and Mughal eras in the capital yesterday.
