Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, three teachers, Maherin Chowdhury, Masuka Begum and Mahfuza Khanam, who died in a plane crash into Milestone School and College, will be remembered forever by the nation as a unique example of humanity and bravery. The Chief Adviser made the remarks when the Family members of the three teachers met him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus thanked British physicians for their timely response to treat the critically injured patients following the plane crash on the compound of Milestone School and College in Dhaka last month. The Chief Adviser said this as the team called on him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed announced a roadmap for judicial reform to establish a strong, independent and impartial judiciary alongside issuing 12-point instructions to bring transparency in the provision of judicial services and introducing a capacity test to provide legal aid to the defendants in cases. The Chief Justice made the announcement when British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Sarah Cooke paid a courtesy call on him at his office in Dhaka yesterday.

European Union (EU) Ambassador in Dhaka Michael Miller said, the EU will provide an assistance package of over four million euro for Bangladesh to help it hold elections in line with international standards. The EU Ambassador made the remarks while talking to reporters after a meeting with Chief Election Commissioner AMM Nasir Uddin at Agargaon's Nirbachan Bhaban yesterday.

Referring to the government's firm stance on elections, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, the government, in line with the Chief Adviser's announcement, is firmly committed to holding the national election next February. The Adviser said this after a meeting at the Cabinet Division in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Education Adviser C R Abrar said that recommendation had been made for the recruitment of 41,000 teachers at the secondary and higher secondary levels under Non-government Teachers Registration and Certification Authority (NTRCA). The Adviser made the comment while inaugurating the 6th recruitment recommendation activities organized by the NTRCA.

Labour and Employment and Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (Rtd.) Dr M Sakhawat Hussain urged China to invest in Bangladesh's port infrastructure and growing ship building sectors. The Adviser made the call during a meeting with Chinese officials at the China's Ministry of Transport the day before yesterday, according to an official handout yesterday. Both the sides also agreed to explore joint initiatives between Mongla Port Authority and China's Yantai Port to improve port facilities and operations.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, the government will continue to work to protect the country's waterbodies aiming to conserve fisheries resources. The Adviser said this while inaugurating a rally at the South Plaza of Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban yesterday. The rally was organized on the second day of the National Fisheries Week 2025. On the occasion, the Adviser said, this year, the country's fishers are playing a leading role in implementing the slogan 'Let's establish sanctuary, fill the country with local fish' aiming to protect fish diversity.

Special Assistant to the Chief Adviser for the Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb said, ensuring cyber security in Bangladesh's banking sector remains a major challenge ahead of the upcoming national elections. He said this while speaking at a seminar titled 'Cyber in Financial Sector of Bangladesh: Security in Digital Future', at a hotel in Dhaka yesterday.

The Ministry of Youth and Sports has officially explained about the information of second phase project to construct mini stadiums at the upazila level. Youth and Sports Secretary Md. Mahbub-Ul- Alam said that the report titled 'Stadium worth TK 51 lakhs was approved to build at a cost of TK 14 cores ' recently published in a newspaper is untrue and factually incomplete. The Secretary explained this at a press conference held at the conference room of Secretariat yesterday.

Army Chief General Waker-Uz-Zaman said, the Army is fully prepared to assist the government in holding free, fair and impartial national elections. The Army Chief said this at a regular 'Officers' Address' held at the Dhaka cantonment in the capital yesterday.

Border Security Force handed over 39 Bangladeshi nationals who were detained different Indian jails to Bangladesh authorities following a meeting at Gangni frontiers of Meherpur. Border Guard Bangladesh 47 Battalion Commander Lieutenant Colonel M Mahbub Murshed Rahman confirmed yesterday.




