Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has called for enhancing the quality and inclusivity of the Bangladesh National Cadet Corps (BNCC) as part of a long-term vision to engage the nation's youth in leadership, discipline, and national development. The Chief Adviser made the remarks after witnessing a presentation titled "National Transformation Through BNCC" by BNCC Director General Brigadier General Abu Sayed Al Masud at the State Guest House Jamuna, said a press release of the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md Jahangir Alam Chowdhury has reiterated that no concession will be given to any criminal involved in setting fire to buses or exploding crude bombs, assuring that there is "nothing to fear." Criminals will not be spared in any way, the Adviser said while briefing journalists after a meeting of the Council of Advisers on Law and Order at the Home Ministry in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. The Home Adviser said there is no apprehension centering the Dhaka lockdown programme by the now-disbanded Awami League, reaffirming, "Nothing to fear."

Education Adviser Professor Dr Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said being elected as the President of the 43rd General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) is a major achievement for Bangladesh in international diplomacy. The Adviser said in an exclusive interview with Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) yesterday.

Food Ministry Adviser Ali Imam Majumdar has emphasized the need for a legal arrangement to protect the country's shrinking farmlands exclusively for agriculture, preventing their conversion for housing, industrial, or commercial purposes to ensure food security for future generations. The adviser made the remarks while presiding over a view exchange meeting on the draft of the "Land Zoning and Agricultural Land Protection Ordinance 2025" at the Land Ministry in Dhaka yesterday.

A high-level delegation from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), led by Tariq H. Niazi, senior director of Public Sector Management and Governance Department, ADB Headquarters in Philippines, and Hoe Yun Jeong, country director of ADB Bangladesh, met with Syeda Rizwana Hasan, the Adviser to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. During the meeting, the Adviser, also the Adviser to the Ministry of Water Resources, underscored the urgent need to safeguard Bangladesh's agricultural land from rapid and unsustainable conversion, noting that the country is losing nearly one percent of its cultivable land each year.

Adviser to the Ministry of Shipping and the Ministry of Labour and Employment Brigadier General (Retd) Dr. M. Sakhawat Hussain said that the government is preparing a comprehensive national strategy titled the "National Port Strategy" aimed at sustainable and long-term development of the country's land, river and sea ports. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a stakeholder consultation meeting held at a hotel in the capital organized by the Ministry of Shipping and supported by the Government of Japan and JICA, to finalize the Bangladesh National Port Strategy 2025 yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on the Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb said that empowering the youth and building a knowledge-based society will be meaningful implementation of the July revolution. The Special Assistant said this while speaking at the inaugural ceremony of the Ulkasemi VLSI Training Institute (UVTI) at the Ulkasemi headquarters in Gulshan here, said a press release yesterday.
