Newsbrief

Chief Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed said, former Attorney General (AG) Senior Advocate AJ Mohammad Ali's important contribution to the country's judiciary will be kept written in the history. The Chief Justice said this while speaking at a memorial meeting organized by 'AJ Mohammad Ali and Associates' at the Supreme Court Bar Association auditorium yesterday. Recalling the contribution of Mohammad Ali, also a former President of the Supreme Court Bar Association, the Chief Justice also said, Mohammad Ali was a man of integrity and was respected by all, including lawyers.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the charge sheet in journalist Asaduzzaman Tuhin murder case in Gazipur will be submitted at the quickest possible time. The Adviser said this while replying to a question from the journalists after coming out of the core committee meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

The nationwide 72-hour transport strike, scheduled to begin on August 12, has been unanimously withdrawn yesterday at the initiative of the Road Transport and Bridges Ministry. The decision was made during a meeting with the Bangladesh Road Transport Owners' Association, held at Bidyut Bhaban in the capital's Abdul Gani Road and organized by the Road Transport and Highways Division. Road Transport and Bridges Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said this following the meeting.

National Security Adviser and High Representative to Chief Adviser for Rohingya Khalilur Rahman said, the 20% tariff imposed by the US on Bangladeshi goods may further come down as the negotiation is underway. The Adviser said this while speaking at a welcome reception programme organized by the Bangladesh Textile Mills Association at Gulshan Club in Dhaka yesterday. At the same programme, Commerce Adviser Sk Bashir Uddin said, they may need to go to the US for negotiations within the next two or three weeks.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said that the government is closely monitoring the activities of Awami League (AL) abroad as the party's activities remained ban in the country. The Press Secretary said this, replying to a question from journalists over the operation of Awami League's party office in Kolkata, while speaking at a press conference at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday. The press conference was organized on the occasion of the Chief Adviser's visit to Malaysia. Bangladesh will seek cooperation from Malaysia on deep-sea fishing, the Press Secretary added.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, the next parliamentary election to be held in 2026 would be the most free, fair and festive manner in the country's history. Referring to the labourers, who sacrificed their lives in the 2024 July Uprising, the Press Secretary said, workers have made the supreme sacrifice for a democratic state, the rights to vote and the establishment of justice. The Press Secretary said this at the closing ceremony of a two-week-long gala programme marking the anniversary of the historic July Uprising at Manarat International University at Khagan in Ashulia yesterday.

Chairman of the Bangladesh Investment Development Authority (BIDA) Chowdhury Ashiq Mahmud Bin Harun said, the capacity of Chattogram Port will increase significantly if the ongoing renovation work is implemented. BIDA Chairman said this while talking to reporters after inaugurating the 'Shipping and Logistics Online Desk' at Gate No. 4 of the New Mooring Container Terminal (NCT) in Chattogram yesterday. Magnetism Tech Limited in collaboration with the port authority will operate the desk. The Chairman also said, container handling capacity has increased by 30 percent and the waiting time of ships has been reduced by 13 hours after the Bangladesh Navy took over the management of the NCT.

The National Consensus Commission has started discussions with experts to ensure the legal binding of July National Charter and find ways to implement the charter. The commission held a discussion with law and constitutional experts at the LD Hall of the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban yesterday.

The government has withdrawn the Bangladesh Police Medal and President Police Medal conferred on 40 fugitive police officials. Home Ministry issued a gazette notification in this regard yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) has published a draft of the supplementary voter list across the country ahead of the 13th general elections. Briefing reporters in front of Nirbachan Bhaban at Agargaon in the capital yesterday, EC Senior Secretary Akhter Ahmed said as of June 30, 2025, the total number of the country's voters stood at 12,61,70,900.

Bangladesh's banking sector has managed to pull back from the brink over the past year, Bangladesh Bank Governor Ahsan H Mansur said, crediting a series of measures taken since he assumed office. The governor said this while speaking at a seminar titled 'Interim Government's 365 Days' organized by Centre for Policy Dialogue in the capital yesterday.
