**Newsbrief**

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said that rice prices in the country are expected to remain relatively stable in the coming months. The Finance Adviser was briefing reporters after holding three separate meetings of the Advisers Council Committee on Economic Affairs, Advisers Council Committee on Government Purchase and the Food Planning and Monitoring Committee at the Cabinet Division Conference Room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, there is no reason for confusion over the upcoming parliamentary election. The Adviser also said, the interim government is fully committed to holding the election in early February and all necessary measures will be taken to ensure a festive and peaceful atmosphere during the polls. The Adviser made the remarks while replying to questions from journalists after a views-exchange meeting with judges at the Legal Aid Office in the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court Building yesterday.

Home Adviser Lt Gen (retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, there was no apprehension over the reported November 13 Dhaka lockdown programme of Awami League, whose activities are now banned. The Adviser said this while replying to questions from journalists following a Core Committee meeting on law and order at his Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. Regarding withdrawal of 50 percent military personnel from the field, the Adviser replied in the negative.


Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, youth force must be transformed into human resources to ensure sustainable development and build inclusive Bangladesh. The Adviser made these remarks while addressing the inaugural ceremony of IDEB's (Institution of Diploma Engineers, Bangladesh) 55th founding anniversary and Public Engineering Day at IDEB Bhaban in capital's Kakrail yesterday.


The government has issued gazette notifications on two groundbreaking laws- the Personal Data Protection Ordinance, 2025 and the National Data Governance Ordinance, 2025, marking a historic step toward ensuring the privacy, security, and ownership of citizens' personal data in Bangladesh. The Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Ministry issued separate notifications on the two ordinances on November 6, according to a press release of the Information and Communication Technology Division yesterday.


