### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, the entire nation will remember Hadi forever and work to fulfill his dream. The Chief Adviser said this while addressing before the namaj-e-janaza of Sharif Osman Hadi at the South Plaza of the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban in Dhaka yesterday.

Shaheed Sharif Osman Hadi, frontline fighter of the July Uprising and Spokesperson of Inqilab Mancha, was laid to eternal rest beside the National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam near the Dhaka University Central Mosque yesterday. Earlier, his namaz-e-janaza was held at the South Plaza of the National Parliament Building after Zuhr prayers. Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus, Advisers, Senior Government Officials, political leaders and tens of thousands of people from all walks of life attended. Hadi's elder brother, Mawlana Dr. Abu Bakar Siddique, conducted the janaza.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has expressed deep shock and sorrow at the death of Air Vice Marshal (Retd) Abdul Karim Khandker, widely known as AK Khandker, Bir Uttam, Deputy Chief of Staff of the Liberation Forces and former Minister. In a condolence message yesterday, the Chief Adviser said that AK Khandker was an unforgettable soldier of Bangladesh's Liberation War. During the Great War of Liberation in 1971, he played a key role in securing the country's independence, demonstrating courage, foresight and leadership, the Chief Adviser noted. The Chief Adviser also prayed for the eternal peace of his departed soul and extended his heartfelt sympathy to his bereaved family members.

Education Adviser Professor Dr. Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said, a vested quarter is carrying out evil efforts to tarnish the spirit of the July Uprising. In a statement yesterday, the Adviser said that because of the evil efforts of that quarter, there is also a risk that the conspiracies of anti-Bangladesh fascist forces may succeed. The Adviser said this when the entire nation is mourning the heart-breaking martyrdom of Sharif Osman Hadi, taking advantage of this incident, a small number of extremist and reckless groups are engaged to create disorder and chaos in different parts of the country.

Liberation War Affairs Adviser Faruk E Azam, Bir Pratik expressed profound shock and sorrow at the death of heroic freedom fighter and Air Vice Marshal (Retd) Abdul Karim Khandker, best known as AK Khandker, Bir Uttam. In a condolence message yesterday, the Adviser recalled that Air Vice Marshal Abdul Karim Khandker was serving as Second-in-Command at the Pakistan Air Force base in Dhaka in 1971. The Adviser also prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul of the late Khandker and expressed heartfelt sympathy to the bereaved family members.

Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (Rtd.) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain inaugurated the Dhalchar (Ananda Bazar) launch ghat in Char Fasson Upazila of Bhola district, built by the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA). In the inaugural ceremony the Adviser said, the people of Dhalchar and Ananda Bazar have been neglected and deprived for generations. With the inauguration of this launch ghat, their long-standing sufferings have come to an end.

The Election Commission (EC) has revised the schedule for filing and disposing of appeals against returning officers' decisions on nomination papers in the 13th Jatiya Sangsad election. According to the revised notification, the time for filing appeals has been shortened by two days and will now run from January 5 to 9, instead of the earlier January 5-11. The period for disposal of appeals has been extended by two days and will take place from January 10 to 18 instead of previously announced January 12-18 timeline.

United Nations (UN) Secretary-General António Guterres has condemned the killing of Sharif Osman Hadi and urged Bangladeshi authorities to ensure accountability through a prompt, impartial and transparent investigation in line with international human rights standards. UN spokesperson Stéphane Dujarric said this at a regular press briefing in New York on Friday that the Secretary-General also called for restraint as Bangladesh moves toward parliamentary elections scheduled for February 2026.

The bodies of six Bangladesh Army peacekeepers, martyred in a terrorist drone attack on a United Nations Mission Base in Sudan, arrived at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka yesterday, drawing solemn tributes from military and civil authorities. Inter-Services Public Relations said this in a press release.
