Newsbrief

A delegation of 21 physicians and nurses from Singapore, China and India met Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. The international medical teams are currently in Dhaka to provide specialised healthcare services to victims of the recent plane crash at Milestone School and College. During the meeting, Prof. Yunus expressed his heartfelt gratitude for the rapid response and medical support extended by the healthcare professionals.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus renewed his call for Malaysia to support Bangladesh's bid to become a member of the ASEAN. The Chief Adviser made the call when Nurul Izzah Anwar, Vice President of Malaysia's People's Justice Party and daughter of Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim, met him at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday visited the National Burn and Plastic Surgery Institute to inquire about the treatment of patients injured in the recent jet crash into Milestone School and College in Uttara. Chief Adviser listened to the description of the incident of that day from its director Professor Mohammad Nasiruddin and asked about the current condition of the injured patients. Professor Nasiruddin said, the patients currently undergoing treatment at the hospital are being treated in consultation with the Multidisciplinary Consultation Board.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday called upon all government and non-government institutions and organizations, media, guardians and conscious civil society to come forward in preventing the silent killer hepatitis. In a message yesterday on the World Hepatitis Day he said, The Chief Adviser said, every year, many people in the country suffer from hepatitis, liver are losing their lives due to complex diseases like cirrhosis, liver cancer and liver failure.

The newly appointed Saudi Ambassador to Bangladesh, Dr. Abdullah Zafer bin Abiyah, paid a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday. The Chief Adviser extended his greetings to the Saudi Ambassador on assuming his duties in Bangladesh and expressed hope that the friendly relations between Bangladesh and Saudi Arabia would reach new heights during his tenure.

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) approved a total of 12 projects involving an overall estimated cost of Taka 8,149.38 crore, including one for further development of the University of Dhaka at a cost of Taka 2,840.39 crore. The approval came from the 12th ECNEC meeting of the interim government and also the 1st meeting in the current fiscal year (FY26) held at the NEC Conference Room in the capital's Sher-e-Bangla Nagar area yesterday. ECNEC Chairperson and Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus presided over the meeting. Planning Adviser Dr Wahiduddin Mahmud briefed reporters after the meeting.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, those implicated in false cases will get justice. The Adviser said this while talking to the journalists after inaugurating the 'July Martyred Memorial' in Munshiganj yesterday. The Adviser said that many innocent people have been accused in different cases and the government has been trying to complete the investigation into those cases.


