Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus inaugurated the 'Navy and Air Force Selection Board-2024' at the Air Force Headquarters in the capital, according to an ISPR press release yesterday. The Chief Adviser also gave instructions on achieving economic prosperity through the conservation and harvesting of the country's marine resources, the contribution of the Bangladesh Navy in the management of the deep sea port, the economic hub of the future and building the necessary skilled human resources for the overall development of the blue economy.

Law Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, the interim government has initiated plans to build a dedicated modern hospital for expatriate community. The move has been taken to acknowledge the contributions of expatriate workers and ensure their well-being, he said. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the 'Remittance Fighters Day' event held at the International Mother Language Institute in the capital yesterday.

Labour and Employment and Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (R.) Dr M Sakhawat Hussain handed over cheques for medical and educational assistance to 22 distressed workers and their families at a ceremony at Deputy Commissioner's Office in Natore yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam said, the country's media should be accountable to the people and it must stand for the truth to restore its trust. The Adviser said this while addressing as the chief guest at a function arranged to honor the families of the martyred journalists and injured media personnel in the July mass uprising at DFP auditorium in Dhaka yesterday. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam spoke as the special guest at the programme organized by Bangladesh Journalist Welfare Trust.

Attorney General Md. Asaduzzaman said, people want maximum punishment through legal framework in a crimes against humanity case against Sheikh Hasina, Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal and Chowdhury Abdullah Al-Mamun. The Chief State Law officer said this while addressing the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT)-1 before the submission of opening statement in the case yesterday.

Chief Prosecutor of the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) Muhammad Tajul Islam said, the ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina was the nucleus of crimes against humanity committed during the July mass uprising. The ICT Chief Prosecutor said these in the opening statement submitted in the crimes against humanity case against Sheikh Hasina, Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal and Chowdhury Abdullah Al-Mamun at the ICT-1 yesterday.

Chowdhury Ashik Mahmud Bin Harun, Executive Chairman of the Bangladesh Investment Development Authority (BIDA) and the Bangladesh Economic Zones Authority (BEZA) said that the government is dedicated to creating an enabling environment for the halal economy, ensuring that Bangladesh becomes a hub for halal products in the region. Chowdhury Ashik said this while speaking as the chief guest at a seminar titled 'Halal Economy 360: Driving Global Growth' at a hotel in the capital yesterday. The Bangladesh-Malaysia Chamber of Commerce and Industry organized the seminar.


