Newsbrief

The Commission of Inquiry on Enforced Disappearances submitted its second interim report titled 'Unfolding the Truth: A Structural Diagnosis of Enforced Disappearance in Bangladesh' to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus the day before yesterday. The Commission revealed that police, Rapid Action Battalion (RAB), Detective Branch (DB), and Counter Terrorism and Transnational Crimes (CTTC) were the main perpetrators behind the enforced disappearances in Bangladesh. Victims, witnesses, and family members most frequently identified the police, RAB, DB and CTTC as the main perpetrators, according to the report of the Commission.

Home Adviser Lt Gen Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (ret'd) said that if everyone maintains discipline and works with patience the law and order and traffic congestion would remain under control. The Adviser said this while speaking to the reporters after visiting the Gabtoli cattle market yesterday.

The government has handed over the title deed of the Gulshan house to Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia. Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan handed over the title deed to Begum Khaleda the day before yesterday.

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court (SC) in its judgement, which reinstated the Supreme Judicial Council to remove apex court judges for incapacity or violating the code of conduct said, the spirit of 16th Amendment case, was to put independence of judges at stake. The observation was made in the full text of the Appellate Division judgment that was pronounced on October 20, 2024. The apex court released the 50-page full-text yesterday.

On the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change urged all citizens to manage sacrificial animal waste in an environmentally responsible manner. Indiscriminate slaughtering of animals and improper disposal of waste during this time often leads to environmental pollution, health hazards and public suffering. This can only be prevented through active and conscious participation by all. Environment, Forest and Climate Change Ministry issued a press release in this regard yesterday.

Sixty-two dengue patients were admitted to different hospitals in the country during the past 24 hours, according to a press release issued by the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
