Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said, the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad election is a major test for the country's law enforcement agencies. The Foreign Affairs Adviser also said, the present interim government wants to hand over the responsibility to the elected government through a fair election. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a view-exchange meeting with Rangpur district officials at the Deputy Commissioner's conference room in Rangpur yesterday.

Education Adviser Professor Dr CR Abrar said, the sacrifice of the 11 scouts who embraced martyrdom during the July Movement continues to inspire the nation in its efforts to build a new Bangladesh. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a national award ceremony organized by Bangladesh Scouts at its headquarters in the capital yesterday.

Road Transport and Bridges Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan emphasized that Bangladesh is a nation of religious diversity and fostering a culture of differing opinions is vital in such a society. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at an inauguration ceremony in Narsingdi yesterday. The Adviser inaugurated the nameplate of the Panchdona-Danga-Ghorashal regional road in Palash, Narsingdi, named in honor of Bir Protik Siraj Uddin Ahmed, also known as Naval Siraj, was a former Pakistan Navy officer, he declared rebellion while on leave in Narsingdi on March 25, 1971, and took part in organizing and leading the Liberation War.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan urged the international community to ensure climate justice and make sure Bangladesh's due share of water to safeguard public health in the coastal region. The Adviser made urges while addressing an international conference on 'Water Security and Climate Change: Local Knowledge, Global Perspectives' at the Nabab Nawab Ali Chowdhury Senate Bhaban at Dhaka University (DU) yesterday. DU Vice-Chancellor Prof. Niaz Ahmed Khan chaired the conference.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the young generation's leadership in wildlife protection is now undeniable. The Adviser stated that the increasing interest among young people in rescuing, caring for and rehabilitating wildlife back into nature is a hopeful sign for Bangladesh. The Adviser made these remarks while speaking at a meeting, held at the Forest Bhaban in Agargaon, Dhaka yesterday. Public awareness on wildlife safety and conservation has risen significantly compared to earlier, the Adviser added.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the nation regards the leadership and wisdom of former Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia as a valuable asset. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified Facebook page shared on Thursday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder said, every child possesses immense hidden potential and the true purpose of education is to nurture that potential and shape them into complete human beings. The Adviser made the remark while addressing a stakeholder meeting organized by the District Primary Education Office on improving the quality of primary education at Cox's Bazar Cultural Center in Cox's Bazar yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhtar emphasized the need for additional funding for women entrepreneurs to address climate risks, highlighting the importance of supporting environmentally sustainable businesses. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at the seminar 'Voices for Change: Putting Climate Action, Women Entrepreneurs, and SMEs in Bangladeshi Public Policy' held at Lakeshore Hotel in the capital yesterday.

Indian High Commissioner Pranay Verma said, India seeks a stable, positive and mutually beneficial relationship with Bangladesh based on equality and mutual respect, in which the people of both nations remain the main stakeholders. The High Commissioner made the remark as the High Commission of India celebrated the 54th anniversary of Maitri Diwas 2025 at the Indian Cultural Centre in Dhaka yesterday, marking India's historic recognition of Bangladesh as an independent state on December 6, 1971.

Malaysian High Commissioner Mohd Shuhada Othman said, Malaysia aims to attract 300,000 Bangladeshi tourists in 2026 under its Visit Malaysia Year campaign, stressing that stronger tourism ties and proper use of the official e-Visa system will ensure smoother travel. The Envoy made the remarks while launching the Malaysia Tourism Fair and the Visit Malaysia Year 2026 promotional campaign at the InterContinental Dhaka's Crystal Ballroom yesterday.

In an effort to stabilize the domestic onion market and ensure prices remain tolerable for consumers, the government has announced that limited scale of onion imports will be permitted from today. According to a press release of the Agriculture Ministry yesterday, 50 Import Permits will be issued daily, with each permit allowing the import of up to 30 tons of onions.

Senior Secretary of the Election Commission (EC) Akhtar Ahmed said, the EC is now fully prepared to hold the upcoming 13th National Parliamentary Election and the referendum. The Senior Secretary made this remark while speaking at a training workshop for journalists on the national election. The workshop was jointly organized at the Election Training Institute in Agargaon yesterday with support from UNDP and the Reporters Forum for Election and Democracy. Regarding the announcement of the election schedule, the EC Secretary also said, no specific date had yet been fixed.

The Election Commission has announced that voters assigned to election duty, government officials posted outside their home constituencies, and individuals in legal custody can apply for postal voting through the 'Postal Vote BD' app until December 25. The registration process will begin from the day the election schedule is announced, according to a PID press release yesterday.

BNP Chairperson's personal physician and BNP Standing Committee Member Dr AZM Zahid Hossain said that the transfer of BNP Chairperson and former Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to London by an air ambulance for advanced treatment might be further delayed. Dr Zahid made these remarks at a press briefing in front of the main gate of Evercare Hospital in the capital yesterday.

Mohammadpur police has submitted a charge sheet against ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, former Ministers Obaidul Quader and Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal and 27 others in connection with the murder of CNG-run auto-rickshaw driver Sabuj. The charge sheet was presented to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court on 27 November after police reportedly found prima facie evidence against the principal accused, according to a press release yesterday.
