### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, a search committee will be formed soon to reconstitute the Election Commission. The Chief Adviser made the announcement during dialogues with political parties held at State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday. The elections-related issues including the preparation of voter list will be discussed later, the Chief Adviser also said, adding that in parallel, the reform commissions will continue their works.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Professor Asif Nazrul clarified his statement over timing of the next general election. The Chief Adviser has the sole authority to announce the election time, the Adviser added. Replying to a question from the Dainik Manabzamin Editor-in-Chief Matiur Rahman Chowdhury at Channel I 'Ajaker Patrika' program on Thursday night.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain is set to depart Dhaka for Samoa in Oceania last night to attend the upcoming Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) there, a Foreign Ministry official confirmed newsmen.

Home Adviser Lt. Gen. Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) sounded a note of warning against filing of harassment cases against innocent people to extort money. The Adviser said this while briefing newsmen at the Rajshahi Sector BGB Headquarters yesterday.

Labour and Employment Adviser Asif Mahmud Sajib Bhuiyan said, stern action will be taken under the Special Powers Act against those involved in syndicates inflating commodity prices. The Adviser made the remarks while exchanging views with government officials of Chattogram Division and District at the local Circuit House yesterday.


Citing middlemen's role as a major problem for raising egg price across the country, Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhtar said, steps will have to be taken to eliminate middlemen's role by forming cooperative societies of egg producers to ensure its supply to consumers directly through dealers. The Adviser said this at a view-exchange meeting with local fishermen and marginalized poultry farmers at the Pabna District Commissioner's office yesterday.

The investigation agency of the International Criminal Tribunal (ICT) yesterday issued a public notice seeking information on the crimes committed to suppress the anti-discrimination student-people movement in July-August last. The notification called upon all to contact the ICT investigation agency's Dhaka office if they have any information, documents, photographs, audio-video clips etc related to killings, serious injury, arson, looting and other crimes for using those in proving the said crimes.
