Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus unveiled the official trophy of the 2nd Women's Kabaddi World Cup 2025. The Chief Adviser unveiled the trophy at the state guest house Jamuna here, in the presence of representatives from all participating nations, according to a press release of the Chief Adviser's Press Wing said yesterday. The ceremony marked the formal kickoff to one of the world's most anticipated women's Kabaddi tournaments and underscored Bangladesh's readiness to welcome the global Kabaddi community. Bangladesh will host the Women's Kabaddi World Cup for the first time, with the tournament scheduled to take place from November 17 to 24, 2025 at the Shaheed Suhrawardy Indoor Stadium in the capital.

Home Adviser Lt Gen (ret'd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, all law enforcement agencies are on full alert ahead of today's verdict in a case filed over crimes against humanity linked to the July Uprising murder charges against deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and former Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan. Speaking to journalists at the Barishal District Police Lines after a view-exchange meeting with field-level officials the Adviser said, overall security preparations have been tightened to prevent any untoward incident. The Adviser also expressed confidence in the preparedness of the field administration for holding the upcoming parliamentary elections peacefully.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan called upon officials of the Public Works Department (PWD) to ensure that all government buildings are constructed and transformed into green buildings. The Adviser made these comments while speaking at a seminar titled 'Environment Management, Green Procurement and Green Building' held at the conference hall of the PWD headquarters in Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser emphasized the urgent need for clear directives in this regard and instructed PWD to prepare a comprehensive Green Building Manual within the next one month.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Sajib Bhuiyan said, the international forensic experts will arrive here on December 5 and forensic tests of the July martyrs buried in Rayerbazaar mass graves will start from December 7. The LGRD Adviser told journalists after visiting the mass graves of martyrs of the July Uprising 2024 at the graveyard adjacent to the Rayerbazaar Martyred Intellectuals Memorial yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter stressed that addressing climate change can no longer be left to profit-driven economies and must instead be guided by young people with a focus on justice. The Adviser made the remarks at an event titled 'The Role of Youth, Government and Social Business in Climate Solutions' at Bangladesh Pavilion in the Blue Zone of the UN Climate Conference COP30 in Belem, Brazil, according to a press release yesterday. Referencing the "Three Zeros" vision-zero poverty, zero unemployment and zero carbon emissions-of Nobel Peace Laureate and Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus, the Adviser said achieving these goals requires a commitment to zero waste and responsible resource use.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Prof Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder said, the Pabna Mental Hospital would be converted into an international standard modern psychiatric institute for the development of the mental health in the country. The Adviser said this while addressing an award giving ceremony and reception organized by Bangladesh Association of Psychiatric at a hotel in the capital yesterday.

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) AMM Nasir Uddin said that the country is undertaking postal voting for the first time in its electoral history, despite the complexities and challenges involved. The CEC told a dialogue session with representatives of registered political parties at the Election Commission building in Agargaon yesterday.

Bangladesh and the United Kingdom (UK) discussed prospects for expanding cooperation in tourism, trade and investment as Bangladesh High Commissioner in London Abida Islam met the Mayor and Mayoress of Oldham, according to the Bangladesh High Commission in London said yesterday. The meeting focused on strengthening economic links, promoting Bangladesh's tourism potential and enhancing investment flows, while also recognizing the significant contributions of the British-Bangladeshi diaspora to the UK.

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 (ICT-1) is set to pronounce its judgment today in a crime against humanity case against three accused - including ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina - over their superior command responsibility for offences committed during the July Mass Uprising. The three-member ICT-1 panel, headed by Justice Golam Mortuza Mozumder, fixed the date on November 13.

About 800 armed force personnel to be sent to Qatar initially for three years under an agreement between Bangladesh and Qatar on deployment of personnel on deputation from the Bangladesh Armed Forces to the Qatar Armed Forces. Principal Staff Officer of the Armed Forces Division of Bangladesh Lieutenant General SM Kamrul Hassan and Chief of Staff of Qatar Armed Forces Lieutenant General (Pilot) Jassim bin Mohammed Al Mannai signed the long-awaited agreement yesterday in Doha, according to a press release of the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Chief of Army Staff General Waker-Uz-Zaman called upon all the members of the Army Ordnance Corps to be ready to face the difficult challenges of the 21st century by acquiring capabilities through modern and up-to-date training with dedication, concentration and professionalism. The Chief of Army Staff General made the call at the 45th Annual Commanders' Conference 2025 of the Army Ordnance Corps at School in Rajendrapur Cantonment in Gazipur yesterday.
