Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday said, the state must be repaired in such a way that whenever signs of fascism are found anywhere, it can be eliminated immediately. The next parliamentary elections will be held in February 2026. The Chief Adviser also called upon the voters to take preparations to elect the best candidates in the upcoming parliamentary polls. The Chief Adviser said these in a televised address to the nation marking July Mass Uprising Day.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus presented the 'July Declaration' before the nation. The declaration was unveiled at a public gathering at South Plaza of the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban yesterday. The meeting was arranged commemorating the July Uprising Day. The student-people uprising of 2024 will be given constitutional recognition to honour the spirit of the injured and fallen martyrs, the Chief Adviser added.

On the occasion of the 'July Mass Uprising Day', Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus inspected the progress of the construction work of the 'July Mass Uprising Memorial Museum' at Ganabhaban in Dhaka yesterday. The museum is under construction as a document of the context, struggle, martyrs and victory of the historic July Uprising of 2024. Upon reaching the construction site, the Chief Adviser exchanged views with the concerned engineers, architects and workers, and directed them to complete the work of the museum as soon as possible.

Law Adviser Asif Nazrul said that even if Sheikh Hasina is tried, it may not be possible to bring her back to Bangladesh. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing the inaugural screening of Prothom Alo's investigative documentary titled 'Bloody Highway: Jatrabari Massacre', held at the newspaper's Karwan Bazar office in Dhaka yesterday, marking the first anniversary of the July mass uprising.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the interim government has taken numerous measures in the last one year following the fall of the Awami League government to make Bangladesh Police a pro-people and service-oriented force inspired by the spirit of the July Mass Uprising. The Adviser told this in interview with BSS yesterday.




