Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus returned home yesterday, wrapping up his four-day official tour to China. Hong Lei, Chinese Assistant Minister for Foreign Affairs and also the Chief Protocol Officer of the Chinese President Xi Jinping, saw off Chief Adviser at Beijing Capital International Airport.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged students to imagine big things always aiming to change the world. The Chief Adviser said this while addressing a function at Peking University (PKU) in Beijing yesterday. Asking the students to look back, he said things happen because somebody imagined. Prof. Yunus encouraged them to imagine the most odd and unhurt things although doing such things seems to be impossible. Later, Chief Adviser received an honorary doctorate degree from PKU.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus invited top Chinese companies to invest in Bangladesh and make the country a manufacturing hub to export their products to the West and Asia day before yesterday. The Chief Adviser hosted four interactive meetings with more than 100 leading entrepreneurs and CEOs of China to share how Bangladesh is now open for business. The Chief Adviser shared his vision of New Bangladesh, the future of trade and the potential of Bangladeshi youth during the sessions.

Newly-appointed Ambassador of Bangladesh to Germany Muhammad Zulqar Nain presented his credentials to the Federal President of Germany Frank-Walter Steinmeier in a formal ceremony held at Bellevue Palace. During the meeting, President Steinmeier congratulated Ambassador Zulqar Nain on his new assignment and reminisced his memories during his visit to Bangladesh and the relationship with Professor Muhammad Yunus, reads a press release from the Bangladesh Embassy in Berlin yesterday.

Newly appointed Bangladesh High Commissioner to South Africa Shah Ahmed Shafi has presented his Letters of Credence to South African President Matamela Cyril Ramaphosa in a formal ceremony held in Pretoria on Thursday, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release yesterday.
