## Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged global investors to come with their investment in Bangladesh as the country has an immense business potential. He made the call while speaking at a private business reception on the sidelines of the Earthna Summit in Doha yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus held a meeting with Sheikha Moza bint Nasser, mother of the Amir of the State of Qatar and Chairperson of Qatar Foundation, on the sidelines of Earthna Summit in Doha, Qatar. He also joined a meeting with Sheikh Thani bin Hamad bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Chairperson of Qatar Fund for Development, on the sidelines of the summit. Besides, the Chief Adviser held a meeting with Nawaf Abdullah Al Hammadi, Assistant CEO for International Operations Sector of Qatar Charity on the sidelines, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder said yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, poverty is created due to a wrong economic system claiming that social business can bring millions of people out of poverty. He said, social business armed with the power of financial inclusion can break free of this trap and can move millions out of poverty. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while delivering his keynote speech on 'Exploring the role of social business, financial inclusion and microfinance in fostering sustainable development and economic opportunities for marginalised communities' at Earthna Summit, organised by Qatar Foundation, in Doha, Qatar yesterday. The Chief Adviser placed six proposals at Earthna Summit, saying the path to a sustainable and equitable future lies in collective action. He urged the global leaders not to forget Palestine and Rohingya crises, saying the Palestinians are not expendable.

Earlier, The Chief Adviser arrived in Doha, Qatar to attend the Earthna Summit 2025 and other engagements. Bangladesh Ambassador to Qatar Md. Nazrul Islam received the Chief Adviser at Hamad International Airport. Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told this yesterday.

Qatar has agreed to renew a recently expired Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on LNG supply for Bangladesh and work on technical details for a proposed land-based LNG terminal in the country. Qatar State Minister for Energy Affairs Saad bin Sherida Al Kaabi gave the assurance when he called on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus on the sidelines of the Earthna Summit in Doha yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus will join the funeral of Pope Francis, Shafiqul Alam, Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser told this in Doha yesterday. The funeral of Pope Francis, whose death prompted an outpouring of grief among Catholics worldwide, will be held on Saturday, according to an announcement of Vatican City.

Home Adviser Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury directed police personnel not to arrest anyone while in plainclothes. The Adviser told this to officers during a view-exchange meeting at the Jashore Deputy Commissioner's conference room yesterday. Addressing the drug issue the Adviser said, the government will not establish drug rehabilitation centers in divisional headquarters of the Narcotics Control Department. He asked law enforcers to focus on preventing drug entry at the borders and dismantling distribution networks nationwide.


Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, enforced disappearances, killings and crimes against humanity remain of the interim government's priority list. The Adviser said these while presiding over a view-exchange meeting organized by the Law and Justice Division on the proposed 'Disappearance Prevention and Remedies Ordinance, 2025', held at the Judicial Administration Training Institute in the capital yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam urged officials and employees of district information offices to actively counter rumours and disinformation at the local level. The Adviser said this at a focus group discussion organized by the Mass Communication Department at the meeting room of the Ministry yesterday. Stressing on expediting the construction of the district information complex across the country, he said that these complexes will play effective role in preserving and disseminating information to a great extent. At the same program, Information and Broadcasting Secretary Mahbuba Farjana said that the communication between district information officers and local journalists should be enhanced to check rumour and disinformation. She also urged the district information officers to play a responsible role in preventing rumors and disinformation.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, Qatar will hire 725 Bangladeshi soldiers to serve in various capacities in the country. The Chief Adviser's Press Secretary told this to on the sidelines of Earthna Summit in Doha yesterday. A high-level Bangladesh delegation, led by Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus, is now visiting Doha to attend the Earthna Summit 2025.


The Interpol has issued a red notice against former Inspector General of Bangladesh Police Benazir Ahmed recently. Assistant Inspector General of Police Md. Inamul Hauque Sagar confirmed the matter yesterday. He said, National Central Bureau (NCB), a unit of the police headquarters, submitted a request earlier to the international criminal police organization to issue a red notice against Benazir.


