Newsbrief

Bangladesh would continue to lend its unwavering support for the just cause of establishing an independent Palestinian state in accordance with multiple UN resolutions. This assurance was made when Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain and Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam held a meeting with International Criminal Court (ICC) Prosecutor Karim A.A. Khan KC on the sidelines of the 'Antalya Diplomacy Forum 2025' in Antalya, Turkey yesterday. During the meeting, the Advisers expressed deepest sympathy over the sufferings of the people of Palestine in the recent aggression. They also appreciated ICC on its stance on the situation in Rohingya crisis and Gaza.

Secretary General of 'Conference on Interaction and Confidence-Building Measures in Asia (CICA) Kairat Sarybay appreciated the contribution of Bangladesh towards the CICA and its active role for implementation of confidence building measures in Asia. He made the remark, while Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain and Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam held a meeting with him on the sidelines of the 'Antalya Diplomacy Forum (ADF) 2025' in Antalya, Turkey yesterday.

Power, Energy and Mineral Resources and Railways Adviser Dr. Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, if there is any load shedding in the coming summer, the capital city Dhaka will experience first the bite and then other parts of the country. The Adviser said these while responding to a question from a journalist about load shedding at a press briefing held at the conference room of the Bangladesh Railway in Chattogram yesterday. Earlier, the Adviser visited Chattogram Railway Hospital and told reporters that railway hospitals across the country will soon begin providing medical services to the general public in addition to railway employees.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, every individual, regardless of their background, has equal rights as citizen of the country, there can be no exceptions. She told the Biju-Sangrai-Boishu-Bishu-Bihu festival 2025 at the Shakyamuni Buddhist Temple in the capital yesterday. At the same programme, the CHT Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma, in his speech, focused on the need for livelihood development in the hill tracts.

United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) assured Dhaka to provide its continued support to Bangladesh especially on Rohingya crisis. The assurance was made when the outgoing UNHCR Representative in Bangladesh Sumbul Rizvi paid a farewell call on Foreign Secretary Md. Jashim Uddin at the Foreign Ministry on Thursday, according a Ministry's press release yesterday.

Bangladesh and European Union (EU) agreed to maintain a constructive and forward-looking dialogue to conclude negotiations on a comprehensive Partnership and Cooperation Agreement (PCA) by next year. The commitment came during the first round of PCA negotiations held on Thursday at the EU Headquarters in Brussels, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release yesterday.

Terming Bangladesh as the worst victim of money laundering, Bangladesh Bank (BB) Governor Dr. Ahsan H Mansur said, vigorous efforts are underway to bring back the money laundered by some family rackets or organized groups from the country's banking sector. He came up with the comments while exchanging views with the media people in Chattogram yesterday.

Another 167 undocumented Bangladeshi migrants were repatriated from Libya with the support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Embassy of Bangladesh in Tripoli and the International Organization for Migration, according to a press release issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs yesterday.

Bangla New Year will be celebrated this year in the name of 'Borshoboron Ananda Shobhajatra' instead of 'Mangal Shobhajatra'. Dean of Fine Arts Faculty of Dhaka University Prof. Azharul Islam Sheikh said this at a press conference yesterday.
