Chief Adviser (CA) Professor Muhammad Yunus greeted the countrymen and all Muslims across the world on the holy month of Ramadan. The Chief Adviser said this in a message yesterday. The Chief Adviser said, soul is purified through self-restraint in this holy month of fasting and restraint. Fasting plays a unique role in establishing mutual sympathy, harmony and brotherhood among the rich and poor, the Chief Adviser added.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) asked all concerned to take action considering crime, not party. The Home Adviser also said, no one in the administration has been told by any department to show sympathy to people of any party. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking to journalists after exchanging views with officials of the Home and Agriculture Ministries at the Cox's Bazar Deputy Commissioner's conference room yesterday.

Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (retd) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain laid emphasis on taking effective measures to protect the rights of workers and increase transparency.
