## Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Touhid Hossain said the government is serious and fully committed to ensuring a free, fair and credible election, stressing that people have long been deprived of their fundamental right to vote. The Adviser said the government would provide all necessary cooperation to the Election Commission to ensure a conducive voting environment, noting that political parties must encourage voters to participate peacefully in the electoral process. The Adviser made the remarks while inaugurating a voting vehicle programme at Bhola Government School ground as the chief guest yesterday.

Education Adviser Professor Dr. Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar said Bangladesh Textile University (BUTEX) has, within a short span of time, proven how a specialized institution can emerge as an important driving force of the national economy through quality education, research and innovation. BUTEX has now become a reliable centre for producing skilled, honest and leadership-oriented human resources for the textile and apparel sector, the Adviser said while addressing the first convocation of Bangladesh Textile University as the convocation president yesterday. The Adviser said BUTEX is contributing significantly to strengthening Bangladesh's textile and garment industry, which remains the backbone of the country's economy. Professor of Hong Kong Polytechnic University Dr Xungai Wang addressed the programme as the convocation speaker while Chairman of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Professor Dr SMA Fayez spoke as the special guest yesterday.

Adviser of LGRD and Cooperatives and Housing and Public Works Adilur Rahman Khan yesterday said that the government is making all-out efforts to ensure citizens' safety and will take strict measures against any attempt to disrupt the upcoming election. The Adviser of the Ministry of Industries, made the remarks after paying respects at the graves of July Uprising martyrs and offering tributes at the July Memorial in Madaripur yesterday. Earlier, the Adviser visited the graves of martyrs Naimur Rahman and Mamun at Mother Bazar, laid flowers at the July Memorial, and inspected the housing project and integrated waste management plant in Shibchar upazila.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said shrimp exporters and producers must follow international standards and practices for exporting shrimp. The Adviser said these while visiting the Faltita Fish Landing Center in Fakirhat upazila of Bagerhat district and exchanging views with fish wholesalers. The Adviser said that the illegal entry of goods from abroad cannot be acceptable as it harms government revenue, and traders also cannot benefit fairly yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said the youth are the country's greatest asset, stressing that skills and competence are the main keys to employment. The government is continuing all-out support to create employment opportunities for the country's four crore youths, the Adviser said while speaking at the UCEP Gazipur Region Job Fair-2025, held at the regional office premises in Salna of Gazipur district yesterday. The Adviser said Bangladesh has a population of 18 crore, and if the four crore youths can be developed into a skilled workforce, a fundamental transformation of the country's socio-economic condition would be possible.

BNP Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman offered prayers at the grave of Shaheed Sharif Osman Bin Hadi, the fearless frontline fighter of the July Uprising and spokesperson of the Inqilab Mancha. Tarique Rahman prayed for the eternal peace of Shaheed Osman Hadi's soul and later offered prayers at the grave of National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam yesterday.

Bangladesh Navy will conduct missile firing in the sea areas between Cox's Bazar and Hatiya on December 29-30, 2025. A release of the Inter Services Public Relations (ISPR) Directorate said yesterday. During this time, all water vessels, fishing boats and trawlers were requested to avoid the above mentioned areas for the safety of lives and property, the ISPR added.
