Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus arrived in Italy yesterday to join the annual World Food Forum (WFF), the flagship event of the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO). Ambassador of Bangladesh to Italy ATM Rokebul Haque received the Chief Adviser at Rome Fiumicino Airport, according to Chief Adviser's Press Wing.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has urged the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to establish a social business fund aimed at supporting young agricultural entrepreneurs, women, farmers and food processors in Bangladesh.

The Chief Adviser made the proposal during a meeting with IFAD President Alvaro Lario on the sidelines of the World Food Forum in Rome of Italy yesterday. During the meeting, the two leaders discussed a range of strategic issues, including support for launching Bangladesh's deep-sea fishing industry, expanding exports of mangoes and jackfruit, promoting climate-resilient agricultural entrepreneurship and assisting buffalo farmers in producing dairy products such as mozzarella cheese. In response, the IFAD President expressed IFAD's keen interest in supporting social business initiatives and expanding collaboration with the private sector in Bangladesh.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, they have decided to refrain from election duties to those being assigned in last three elections under the fascist regime for holding the upcoming general polls in a free, fair and impartial manner. The Adviser made the remarks while briefing newsmen about the outcome of core committee meeting on the law and order at the Home Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. The Adviser also said, the government is imparting training to around 7.68 lakh law enforcers that include, police, BGB and Ansar aimed at holding a free, fair, peaceful and neutral parliamentary election slated for next February.

Health and Family Welfare Adviser Nurjahan Begum Sharmeen said, the National Typhoid Vaccination Campaign 2025 is a milestone initiative for health protection of children. The Adviser also sought everyone's cooperation to make the campaign a grand success. The Adviser said this as chief guest at the inaugural ceremony of the Typhoid Vaccination Campaign 2025 at Sir Salimullah Muslim Orphanage in the capital yesterday. At the same programme, Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid also spoke as the special guest.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder urged everyone to remain vigilant in preventing typhoid. The Adviser made the call while addressing the inaugural ceremony of the 'Typhoid Vaccination Campaign 2025' at Dhaka Residential Model College yesterday as the chief guest.

Religious Affairs Advisor Dr A.F.M. Khalid Hossain announced that the historic Andarkilla Shahi Jame Mosque in Chattogram will undergo a transformation into a stunning and iconic mosque. 


