### Newsbrief

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, sustainable development cannot be achieved without safeguarding the environment by controlling air, water, soil and noise pollution. The Adviser made these remarks while addressing a discussion arranged, marking the 75th founding anniversary of Dhaka University's Department of Geography and Environment at the Central Playground of the university yesterday.

The Ministry of Liberation War Affairs published a gazette notification recognising 493 individuals injured in the July mass uprising as 'July Warriors'. The Ministry issued the gazette on Thursday categorising 493 critically injured individuals under 'Category A'.

Commerce Adviser Sheikh Bashir Uddin assured that the supply of all commodities in the market ahead of holy Ramdan would be ensured within a week. The Adviser said the journalist following a meeting with tannery owners at Hemayetpur yesterday. The Adviser visited central effluent treatment plant (CETP) of BSCIC Industrial city at Harindhara of Hemayetpur, Savar yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter warned that the government would not spare anybody to be found responsible for price hike of essentials. The Adviser said this while inaugurating selling of milk, eggs and meat at fair price on the occasion of holy Ramadan at Siraj Mia Memorial Model School premises at Merul Badda area yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain said, the government is undertaking diverse initiatives to promote and develop Islamic culture and values. The Adviser emphasized on encouraging the practice of these values across the country while addressing an award-giving ceremony as chief guest. Islamic Foundation (IF) organized the ceremony of "National Children- Adolescent Islamic Cultural Competition-2025" at the IF Auditorium in the capital's Agargaon yesterday.

The newly launched political party, the National Citizen Party (NCP), led by Students Against Discrimination and initiated by the Jatiya Nagorik Committee, was officially launched as Convenor Nahid Islam read out the party's declaration. Mim Akhter, sister of a July martyr Ismail Hossain Rabbi, announced the top leadership of the central committee at the inauguration yesterday on Manik Mia Avenue, in front of the National Parliament Building in Dhaka.

United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) Filippo Grandi yesterday visited the Rohingya camps in Ukhia, Cox's Bazar. Filippo Grandi witnessed the activities of UNHCR-run registration center there. UNHCR Regional Director for Asia and the Pacific Hai Kyung Jun, Refugee Relief and Repatriation Commissioner Mizanur Rahman, officials of various UN agencies, and concerned officials of the camp administration were present at the time.

A recent video of a motorcycle hijacking at gunpoint in broad daylight in the capital's Hatirjheel area by four youths that went viral on social media was actually a shooting scene. Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) in a statement confirmed the matter yesterday.

BNP Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman made a humble request to the followers of Sanatan religious community to remain vigilant so that vested quarters cannot use their religious identity for their own interest in the future. The BNP Acting Chairman made the call while speaking virtually as chief guest at the biennial conference of Shree Shree Janmashtami Udjapan Parishad Bangladesh Central Committee at capital's JM Sen Hall yesterday.

Fact-checking body Rumor Scanner in an investigation revealed that the Binance account screenshots circulating in the names of the interim government's Advisers, the press Secretary, and leaders of the July-August uprising are fake. In a report published on its website yesterday, the fact-checking organization said these screenshots have been created through technological manipulation and are being circulated, citing an unreliable source. These viral screenshots are being spread, claiming that the accounts in the names of the relevant individuals have a huge amount of Bitcoin deposited, amounting to hundreds of crores of taka.
