Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged all to become proactive in ensuring the best use of intellectual property and protecting copyrights so that a prosperous Bangladesh can be built in the days to come. The Chief Adviser said this in a message marking the World Intellectual Property Day to be observed today. Proper implementation of intellectual property laws and policies is necessary to build a strong connection between the creativity, innovation and economic progress of the music industry, the Chief Adviser added.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus paid tribute to late Pope Francis at Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City. The mortal remains of Pope Francis were lying in state there ahead of Saturday's funeral. His Most Reverend Eminence Cardinal Mauro Gambetti, Vicar General of His Holiness for Vatican City, offered an official greeting to the Chief Adviser and the Bangladesh delegation at St. Peter Square. Later on Saturday, Prof. Yunus will again visit St. Peter Square to join the Funeral Mass of His Holiness Pope Francis.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus arrived in Italy to attend the funeral of His Holiness Pope Francis. The Chief Adviser arrived in Rome at about (Italy time), where he was received by the Bangladesh Ambassador to Italy and the Bangladesh Ambassador to Vatican City, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told this to BSS yesterday.

The interim government has decided to set up a land-based LNG terminal to ensure smooth gas supply to the country's factories. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam told reporters in Doha day before yesterday. In this regard, he said, a plan was shared with Qatar Energy during the Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus's tour to Doha. The land-based LNG terminal will be set up soon to expend gas supply to factories in Bangladesh, the Press Secretary added.

Chief Justice Dr. Syed Refaat Ahmed said, Bangladesh and Turkey share common objectives in terms of ensuring justice, protecting human rights, and upholding the rule of law. The Chief Justice was addressing a special session marking the 63rd anniversary of Turkey's Constitutional Court in Istanbul, according to a press release yesterday. On behalf of Bangladesh's judiciary, Dr Ahmed greeted the people of Turkey and their constitutional institutions, particularly the Turkish Constitutional Court

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said, the present government wants to take the country forward by maintaining communal harmony. The Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser said these while addressing as the chief guest at a daylong seminar on things to do for the socio-economic development of Bangladesh and development of Buddhist culture in the country. Organised jointly by Uddhist Religion Welfare Trust and Ministry of Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs, the seminar was held in the hall room of the Chittagong Hill Tracts Development Board in Rangamati district yesterday.

Federal Minister for Defence of Pakistan Khawaja Muhammad Asif lauded Bangladesh's significant progress in the socio-economic sector. Highlighting the historical ties and bilateral relations between Bangladesh and Pakistan, he emphasized the necessity of further strengthening these relations to enhance development cooperation between the people of both countries. He made the laude while spaking as the chief guest at the celebrating programe marking the Independence and National Day of Bangladesh at Bangladesh High Commission in Islamabad of Pakistan on Tuesday, according to a press release of Bangladesh High Commission in Pakistan yesterday.

The office of Dr. Asif Nazrul, Adviser to the Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs of the Interim Government of Bangladesh, has strongly refuted a report published by the Indian news portal 'News Arena India', terming it false, defamatory and irresponsible. In an official statement issued on Thursday, the Law Adviser's spokesperson refuted claims made in the April 24 article titled "B'desh legal advisor meets top LeT Operative post J&K attack," in which allegation was made that Dr. Nazrul met with a senior Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) operative following the April 22 Pahalgam massacre in Indian-administered Kashmir. The statement described the article as fiction, devoid of any factual basis.

Labour Reform Commission has recommended making online submission of wage payment information mandatory by the factory owners to the Department of Inspection for Factories and Establishments (DIFE) every month. The Commission made the recommendation in its report submitted to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. Head of the Commission Syed Sultan Uddin Ahmed submitted the report to the Chief Adviser at the state guest house Jamuna recently.
