Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus left Dhaka yesterday for London on a four-day official visit to the United Kingdom aiming to enhance bilateral relations. Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told this to newsmen.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Rtd) Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that the overall law and order in the country during Eid-ul-Azha was satisfactory. The Adviser said this while talking to journalists after visiting Jatrabari police station in the capital yesterday.

Home and Agriculture Adviser lieutenant general (Rtd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that the government will soon enact a new law to protect the agricultural land for the interest of the farmers. The Adviser said this while talking to journalists at Arai hazar Narayanganj after visiting the Bangladesh Institute of Research and Training on Applied Nutrition in Dhaka yesterday.

Industries Adviser Adilur Rahman said, rawhides of more than 3.5 lakh sacrificial animals have so far been preserved in the tanneries of Bangladesh Small and Cottage industry Corporation (BSCIC) in Savar this year. The Adviser said this while addressing a meeting with tannery owners at BSCIC Savar yesterday. The Adviser also said, this year the government has tried to ensure the proper storing of the rawhides and allow the sellers getting price of the rawhides as fixed by the government.

LGRD and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the Election Commission will provide a election schedule in due time in line with the announcement of the Chief Adviser. The Adviser said this while exchanging views with local journalists at Jahapur Bazar in Cumilla yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, a clean city is not just a goal, but a responsibility of everyday. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified facebook page yesterday.

Commerce Adviser Sk. Bashir Uddin said that a huge anarchy had prevailed in the country's leather sector over the last 15 years during the previous regime, which led to a drastic fall in this sector. The Commerce Adviser said this while talking to journalists after visiting the activities related to the management of rawhides of sacrificial animals at Rajarhat in Jashore yesterday.
