Newsbrief

US President Donald Trump has greeted Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus and people of Bangladesh on the occasion of Independence Day. The US President said this in a message sent to the Chief Adviser yesterday. The US President also said, the United States looks forward to continuing partnership with Bangladesh in this coming decisive year.

The United Kingdom, Russian Federation, Pakistan and China yesterday extended their congratulations to Bangladesh on the occasion of its Independence Day. King Charles III of the UK sent a congratulatory letter to the President of Bangladesh. Russian President Vladimir Putin also sent separate letters to the President and the Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. In his letter to Prof. Yunus, Putin stated that Russia-Bangladesh relations have been developing in the spirit of friendship and mutual respect. Pakistan's Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif also congratulated Chief Adviser Prof. Muhammad Yunus on the occasion of Bangladesh's National Day. Emphasising the deep historical, cultural and religious ties between the two countries, he expressed encouragement that Pakistan-Bangladesh relations have entered a new era of understanding and cooperation in recent times. The Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Bangladesh also greeted the people of Bangladesh. It posted this on its official Facebook page.

Indian President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi felicitated their Bangladeshi counterparts and the people of Bangladesh on the occasion of the country's Independence Day. They reiterated India's commitment to advancing partnership with Bangladesh for peace, stability and prosperity. The Indian Prime Minister said this in a message to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday arrived in Hainan, China to join the Boao Forum for Asia (BFA) conference. Bangladesh Ambassador to China Md. Nazmul Islam and the Vice Governor of the Hainan Province received the Chief Adviser at the airport.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus asked the Asian countries to chart a clear roadmap for a shared future and prosperity. The Chief Adviser said this while addressing Boao Forum for Asia (BFA) conference in Hainan today. About financial cooperation, the Chief Adviser said, Asia must create a sustainable financing mechanism and regional Multilateral Development Banks (MDB) and similar institutions should lead this effort. Regarding trade cooperation, the Chief Adviser said, Asia remains one of the least integrated regions. This weak integration stifles investment and trade. We must work to boost trade cooperation immediately, he noted.

Executive Vice Premier of the State Council of China Ding Xuexiang called on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus on the sidelines of the Boao Forum for Asia (BFA) conference in Hainan, China today. Energy Adviser M Fouzul Kabir Khan, High Representative to the Chief Adviser Dr. Khalilur Rahman, Principal Secretary on SDGs Affairs Lamiya Morshed and Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam were present. Chen Huaiyu, Chairman of The Export-Import Bank of China, also called on Chief Adviser at Boao State Guest House in Hainan.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) paid glowing tributes to the martyred police personnel during the Great War of Liberation marking the Independence and National Day. He paid the rich tribute to the martyrs after placing a floral wreath at the Police Memorial, Rajarbagh Police Lines in the capital yesterday. Special Assistant to the Chief Adviser Md. Khuda Baksh Chowdhury and Inspector General of Police (IGP) Baharul Alam also paid tributes to the great sons of the soil.

Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuiyan said that Bangladesh is now fully independent and that its citizens will never feel enslaved on this land again. The Adviser told this to reporters after paying tribute to the martyrs of the Liberation War at the National Martyrs' Memorial in Savar yesterday on the occasion Independence and National Day.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid said, independence Bangladesh was achieved through an armed struggle. The Adviser said this while speaking at a programme of 'Khatome Quran, discussion and milad mahfil' held at the south plaza of the Baitul Mukarram National Mosque yesterday. Islamic Foundation Bangladesh arranged the programme on the occasion of the great Independence and National Day.

Railways Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, the government is taking effective measures to make Bangladesh Railway economically viable through reducing losses and checking corruption. The Adviser said this while inaugurating a new pair of commuter trains on the Dhaka-Narasingdi-Bhairab Bazar route and the replacement of the rakes of the Narayanganj Commuter Train plying on the Dhaka-Narayanganj route at Kamalapur Railway Station yesterday.

The United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution on the scope, modalities, format, and organisation of the high-level conference on the situation of Rohingya Muslims and other minorities in Myanmar under the sponsorship of Malaysia and Finland on Tuesday. The Permanent Representative of Bangladesh, Ambassador Md. Salahuddin Noman Choudhury made an intervention during the open debate session yesterday.

Deputy Commanding General of the U.S. Army Pacific Lt. Gen. Joel P. Vowell visited Bangladesh from March 24 to 25 to strengthen military cooperation between the two nations. The visit reinforced the US Army's commitment to a robust partnership with the Bangladesh Army while underscoring shared security interests and ongoing collaboration, according to a media note issued by US Embassy in Dhaka yesterday.
