Newsbrief

The Commission of Inquiry on Enforced Disappearances, led by its President Justice Moyeenul Islam Chowdhury, submitted its final report to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus, stating that enforced disappearances in Bangladesh were largely politically motivated and carried out with involvement from the highest levels of the immediate past government. The report titled 'Unfolding the truth: a structural diagnosis of enforced disappearance in Bangladesh' was handed over at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday, according to a press release of the Chief Adviser's press wing.

Chief Justice Zubayer Rahman Chowdhury said, positive steps would be taken to reduce the backlog of cases in courts through the adoption of technological measures. The Chief Justice urged lawyers to uphold the dignity and sanctity of the legal profession both inside and outside court premises. He also stressed the importance of ensuring security for judges, lawyers and litigants. The Chief Justice made the remarks while addressing a reception hosted to him by the Attorney General's Office and the Supreme Court Bar Association at Courtroom of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, some 18,000 youths will be trained under a freelancing training project. Asif Nazrul said, freelancing has immense potential for educated youths of the country. The Adviser also noted that freelancing needs to be expanded further as it allows individuals to work without running after jobs and does not require significant investment to start earning or doing business. The Adviser made the remarks while inaugurating a three-month-long training course at the conference room of the Ministry of Youth and Sports at the Secretariat yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser to the interim government Dr. Asif Nazrul welcomed the decision of the Bangladesh Cricket Board (BCB) not to send the national team to India to play World Cup matches. The Adviser said this in a Facebook post yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd.) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury has called on all members of the police force to perform their election-related duties with the highest standards of responsibility, integrity and professionalism. The Adviser made the remarks while inspecting a training workshop at the Dhaka Metropolitan Police Training Academy in Rajarbagh, aimed at enhancing the efficiency and capacity of police personnel in election duties.

Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder said, the country is currently holding its highest-ever food stock, with accumulated reserves standing at more than 20.27 lakh metric tons. The Adviser made the remarks at a press conference at his Ministry office in the Secretariat yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, no contesting political party has so far lodged any complain about the environment of coming national election. The country is moving forward with all preparations for a free, fair and peaceful election amidst a very conducive situation, she said. The Adviser made the remark while responding to questions from journalists at an exchange of views with Bangladesh Secretariat Reporters Forum (BSRF) at Secretariat Media Center yesterday.


With a view to building an inclusive society, Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid inaugurated the construction works of 'Ashar Alo', a special educational institution for children with special needs in the capital's Khilkhet area yesterday. The school is being constructed under the supervision of the Ministry of Social Welfare and conducted by the Bangladesh Navy. In her inaugural speech, the Adviser said, the institution is not just an educational institution; it is a shining example of hope, humanity and building an inclusive society.

The government has taken necessary measures to ensure availability of quality jute seeds in the current season, and there will be no shortage, said Adviser to the Ministries of Textile and Jute, and Commerce Sk. Bashir Uddin. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a meeting with leaders of the Bangladesh Jute Spinners Association at his office at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Election Commissioner Brigadier General (ret'd) Abul Fazal Md. Sanullah said, there would be no scope for exerting any unethical influence in the upcoming Jatiya Sangsad election. The Election Commissioner also said, strict measures would be taken to prevent Rohingyas from engaging in any election-related activities. The Adviser said this while speaking at a views-exchange meeting organized by the Law and Order Maintaining Cell at the Cox's Bazar Deputy Commissioner's Office yesterday.

After scrutiny of the nomination papers by the Returning Officers and Assistant Returning Officers in all 300 constituencies a total of 1,842 candidates have been declared valid for 13th Parliamentary Election. Nomination papers of 723 candidates have been rejected on different grounds, according to a notification of the Election Commission (EC) said yesterday.

Rapid Action Battalion (RAB) Director General (DG) and Additional IGP AKM Shahidur Rahman said, his force is working with utmost sincerity and dedication to ensure the upcoming national elections are free, fair, impartial and festive. The RAB Chief made the remarks at a press conference held at the RAB Media Center in Karwan Bazar yesterday.
