Newsbrief

Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, the interim government has been working to hold a good election for the welfare of the country. The Adviser made the comments while answering to question of a journalist during his visit to the gas exploration side at Tartapara village in Madarganj Upazila of Jamalpur district yesterday.

A significant bilateral meeting took place at the headquarters of the Turkish Football Federation (TFF) in Istanbul yesterday between Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Sajib Bhuiyan and TFF President Ibrahim Ethem Hacosmanolu. During the meeting, both sides agreed to enhance cooperation in the development of football. The Sports Adviser highlighted the recent resurgence of football in Bangladesh, including the inclusion of players of Bangladeshi descent in the national team and ongoing efforts to establish a sustainable football ecosystem.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives and Youth and Sports Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said that the 10 posters drawn by Artist Debashis Chakraborty are reflecting the importance of July. The Adviser said this in his verified Facebook post yesterday.

A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Ministry of Youth and Sports Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain and President of World Ethnosports Union (WEU) Necmeddin Bilal Erdoganat at the headquarters of WEU in Istanbul yesterday to promote traditional sports and cultural cooperation.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Mahfuz Alam has opened up about the 'meticulous design' of the July movement. The Adviser said, the first part is definitely meticulously designed. The credit for the next part goes to the revolutionary students and the masses. The Adviser said this in his Facebook post yesterday.

Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmin Murshid said, the government is finding it a 'bit difficult' to issue certificates for all the martyrs as there were too many participants in last year's anti-fascist movement. The Adviser informed reporters about the challenges during a visit to the houses of two martyrs at Tongi, Gazipur yesterday.

Religion Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain said, if every member of society focuses on practicing religion, the crime rate will fall in the society. The Adviser made the remarks as the chief guest while laying the foundation stone of a model mosque and inaugurated the construction work of two other mosques in Hathazari, Raojan and Rangunia upazilas of Chattogram yesterday.

Nepalese Ambassador in Dhaka, Ghanshyam Bhandari said, the trilateral energy deal under which Bangladesh has started importing hydroelectricity from Nepal, through using Indian grid under a five year deal, is a milestone in Nepal-Bangladesh ties. The import will be from June 15 to November 15 every year. The Ambassador said this while addressing a programme in the Nepal Embassy in Dhaka yesterday.

Deputy Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser, Abul Kalam Azad Majumdar said that many television channels and newspapers played their biased role during the past autocratic regime, but none of them have offered apologies so far. Many of them served as the publicity tools for the then government and actively incited violence during the July student-people mass uprising. He wrote this in a post on his verified Facebook page yesterday.

As many as 204 new patients have been hospitalized with dengue fever while no fatalities were reported from the Aedes mosquito-borne disease across Bangladesh over the past 24 hours, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
