A delegation from Japan's National Business Support Combined Cooperatives (NBCC) met with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus to inform about the progress on the recruitment of 100,000 skilled Bangladeshi workers in Japan. They met the Chief Adviser on Sunday at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka, according to a press release of the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Dhaka and Islamabad have agreed to strengthen further cooperation in various sectors like trade, agriculture, IT, food, energy, pharmaceutical and connectivity as the 9th meeting of the Bangladesh-Pakistan Joint Economic Commission (JEC) was held at the NEC Conference Room in the capital yesterday. Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed and the visiting Pakistan Petroleum Minister Ali Pervaiz Malik led their respective delegations in the meeting.

The Adviser made this remark while addressing a national event titled 'UK-Bangladesh Collaboration on Ecology-Based Adaptation and Hydro-Met Services' held at Pani Bhaban in Dhaka yesterday.

Shipping and, Labour and Employment Adviser Brig Gen (retd) Dr M Sakhawat Hussain said, there is no confusion over the upcoming Jatiya Sangsad election as the interim government is ready to assist the Election Commission in holding the polls. The Adviser made the comments after inaugurating the newly constructed three-storey terminal building at Betua River Port in Charfession upazila of Bhola district yesterday.






